CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS Event on positive behaviour begins

A two-day programme to spread awareness about how to behave with children with special needs both at home and school started in Chittagong city yesterday.

Under the programme titled "Learning Disabilities and Behavioural Approach", a seminar was organised in the LGED auditorium of Sholoshahar yesterday while a workshop will be held today.

Frobel Play School, a preschool in the port city which also provides assistance to children with special needs, is hosting the event to inform people about barriers that these children face every day, especially in mainstream schools, and to introduce a guideline for teachers on how to impart lessons effectively to such students. The Daily Star is the media partner.

Social Welfare Minister Syed Mohsin Ali inaugurated the programme where over 300 schoolteachers were present alongside guardians, and government and private organisation officials.

Dr Geet Oberoi, founder president of Orkids, a multi-disciplinary clinic in Delhi, presented a keynote paper underscoring inclusive education for students with disabilities.

Dr Alefiya Nomanbhoj of the University of Nottingham presented another paper on positive behavioural supports towards these children.

Aouana Marzia, faculty member of Proyash Institute, moderated the programme, while Madhuri Banerjee, head of Unicef's Chittagong office; Dr Basana Muhuri, associate professor of Chittagong Medical College; Huwra Tehseen Zohair, principal of Frobel; Bandana Das, deputy director of the social welfare department; Dr Mahmood Ahmed Chowdhury of Maa O Shishu Hospital, and Dr Fahmida Islam Chowdhury spoke among others.

Milk selling at Tk 10

unrest featuring the nonstop transport blockade from January 6 and frequent hartals.

The employees of "Pran Milk" at Bera in Pabna said they had to keep milk collection suspended for two weeks without any announcement.

Nitaya Gopal Gosh, a dairy farmer of Sonatola village in Santhia upazila, said he was forced to sell about 160kg of milk at Tk 10-12 per kg in the local market on January 16 as "Pran Milk" Bera unit did not buy his milk.

He had to count loss amounting to Tk 30,000 since after the start of the blockade as the milk processing companies did not collect milk from him.

Rafiqul Islam, managing director of "Pran Milk" at Bera unit, said their everyday collection of milk from the local dairy farmers is around 50,000 litres but they are now unable to collect it as vehicles are not available for carrying the item.

Besides, "Milk Vita" in Sirajganj reduced buying milk due to the same reason. As a result, the supply has increased here as huge

quantity of milk comes to our company from that area," said Rafiqul Islam.

"Aarong Milk" (a Brac-run company) Bera upazila unit Manager Orbindu Rudra said, "We are not buying milk due to transport problems."

Dairy farmers of Sonatola village in Santhia upazila said they supply milk to the government milk processing company "Milk Vita" through a local cooperative but the company has closed collection due to the blockade.

Charachithulia Purbapara Prathamik Dugdha Utpadan Samaboy Samity Manager Mobarok Hossain said "Milk Vita" has kept milk collection totally stopped for the last seven days.

"We have sold milk at Tk10-12 per litre in the local market for want of customers," he added.

Milk Vita Deputy General Manager Dr Khandaker M Aminul Islam said the information of keeping the milk collection stopped is not correct.

"We were unable to collect milk for certain reasons for several days but now efforts are on to make a way out from this," he added.

terrorism "by the BNP-led alliance" and that BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia would face legal action for "masterminding the killings".

Opposition leader Raushan Ershad, on visiting burn victims at Dhaka Medical College Hospital, said a resolution would come within a few days over the current political deadlock.

"We all are trying to resolve the political crisis. We are holding talks both inside and outside parliament. Hope a fair resolution

will come soon," she said.

Contacted, AL Joint General Secretary Mahbubul Alam Hanif said the arrest of arsonists and bomb-makers would do the trick.

"Police have got lists of bomb-makers, their patrons and financiers. Many of them have already been arrested and the remaining will be nabbed soon," he said.

On Thursday, AL stalwart and lawmaker Tofail Ahmed in parliament specifically set the timeframe at seven days.

Rice godowns looted in Jhenidah

Robbers looted 365 sacks of rice and Tk 62,000 from two rice godowns in Shailokupa bazar of Shailokupa upazila of Jhenidah on Thursday.

The godown owners said, around 2:30am a gang of robbers numbering 25-30 entered the godowns breaking open the locks after tying the guard with ropes. They looted 350 sacks of rice and Tk 7,000 from Bashu Shaha's godown and the remaining from Rima Dey's godown.

"My Soil, My Soul", organised by Chittagong Photo Journalist Association (CPJA), Indira Gandhi Cultural Centre and Agartala Press Club, according to Indian media reports yesterday.

"We do not want to remain satisfied with the photographs only. We want to make a lively relation with Chittagong," he said.

He said people of the region had long been demanding access to the port and introduction of transshipment of goods through this port.

He added that if commercial and economic exchange programmes took place, both the countries would be benefited and bilateral relation would be further improved.

Sarkar said the relation between Bangladesh and India was very cordial now and acknowledged that the 726 megawatt gas-based thermal power project in Gomati district in the state could not have been possible if Bangladesh had not allowed use of its sea and riverine routes and the Ashuganj river port on Meghna for shipment of machines for the project.

He also appreciated Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi's initiative to resolve pending issues like water sharing of the Teesta river and the land boundary agreement for exchange of enclaves and boundary demarcation.
