

Dhaka sees human chain face-off

AL, BNP supporters gather at Press Club simultaneously accusing each other for country's current political crisis

A number of pro- and anti-government organisations held programmes simultaneously before Jatiya Press Club in the capital yesterday centering the ongoing turmoil across the country. The bodies backed by the government protested the violence during the indefinite blockade enforced by the BNP-led 20-party alliance while the other side demanded withdrawal of cases and release of the alliance's leaders. At a human chain formed by Bangabandhu Engineers' Council, Housing and Public Works Minister Engineer Mosharraf Hossain criticised BNP as it continue its blockade violence during the party's three-day programme to mourn the death of Arafat Rahman Koko.

Following his death, Koko's mother Khaleda Zia, BNP chairperson, should have felt the grief of people, who lost their near and dear ones in the violence, he said. "There is a justice of Allah and it may be an indication from the Almighty," the minister said, urging Khaleda to refrain from the violence. Pro-government Journalists Society against Violence, and Bangladesh Transport Labour Party did the same at the venue. In a rally jointly staged by the factions of the Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalist and the Dhaka Union of Journalists, Ruhul Amin Gazi, former president of the BFUJ faction, said the government could not found the way out after some day when it would fall. RU teachers, students protest blockade, arson

Demand resumption of classes

Teachers, students and staff of Rajshahi University (RU) yesterday protested the ongoing countrywide blockade and demanded resumption of regular classes and examinations.

At a human chain on the campus, over a hundred teachers under the banner of "Progressive Teachers' Association" protested the countrywide violence, which stemmed from the blockade enforced by the BNP-led alliance. The pro-liberation association condemned the politics of the alliance saying that the parties want to grab power by shedding blood of the common people. The teachers also urged the university authorities to resume regular classes as soon as possible. Meanwhile, activists and leaders of the university unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League as well as general students demanded that the authorities restart classes within this Saturday. They threatened to wage a tough movement if their demand is not met. Chhatra Federation, RU unit also made a similar demand at a press conference on the campus yesterday.

Political crisis will be resolved on streets: Inu

Rules out possibility of immediate talks

The political impasse in the country would be resolved on the streets, not at a table, said Information Minister Hasnul Haq Inu yesterday. Addressing a programme organised by Bangladesh Secretariat Reporters Forum at the Secretariat, Inu said the government had taken steps to stop hit and run attacks and ensure public safety. "If a bomber has to go to prison then Khaleda also has to go to prison as an instigator," Inu said. Ruling out the possibility of any immediate dialogue, he said, the BNP-led alliance would have to shun violence and create a congenial atmosphere if it wants to hold talks with the ruling Awami League. Terming Khaleda the queen of instability, terrorism and sabotage, Inu said the government would not sit for dialogue with a party that does not believe in democracy.

BTCL's uncollected bills Tk 1,800cr

About to embark on a drive for collection; defaulters are govt, non-govt, private agencies, individuals

Bangladesh Telecommunications Company Limited (BTCL) has taken initiatives to realise outstanding bills accumulating Tk 702 crore till 2014 from various local agencies as well as individuals. BTCL Managing Director eng Mahfuz Uddin Ahmed said it undertook a scheme to realise the outstanding phone bills from government and private agencies, and general customers by giving them 5-6 months. "If this flexible approach fails to realise the dues, we'll take legal action against the defaulters," he added. Mahfuz also said they were trying to realise outstanding phone bills of Tk 1,062 crore from different international call carriers through legal procedure. According to BTCL statistics, government agencies owe Tk 102.46 crore, semi-govt organisations Tk 12.10 crore, private agencies (post-paid system) Tk 989.11 crore and 26 national foreign carriers Tk 73.55 crore. Besides, Tk 247.65 crore have been due as some telephone lines were disconnected due to non-payment of bills. Moreover, 15 foreign private carriers (pre-paid system) have a total of Tk 10.93 crore due to BTCL, while 52 foreign private carriers (post-paid system) Tk 989.11 crore and 26 national foreign carriers Tk 73.55 crore. BTCL Director (international) Sharifuzzaman said international calls enter

Bangladesh using BTCL's network and the call carriers have to pay Tk 1.5 cent per minute. Failing to realise the dues, BTCL has stopped services of some international and national operators, he said, adding that the services of only two out of 78 international carriers (private), and 17 out of 26 international carriers (national) are operative, he added. At present, 9.26 lakh customers have BTCL's line (connection). The company stopped providing services to one lakh customers due to various reasons, including non-payment of phone bills, said the BTCL boss. BTCL counted a loss of Tk 3 crore last year due to cable theft, drop wire and some other reasons, he said, adding that some steps had been taken to make profit this year. Referring to its new venture, Mahfuz said the company would introduce a new service named "Triple Play" with voice, video and data services. The customers can easily watch TV programmes by availing the service at a low price. Apart from it, the BTCL has given optical link connection to 108 unions across the country while 1,000 more unions will also get the facility soon, he said. He also said BTCL opened a new monitoring cell named System and Service Improvement (SSI) on January 21 for strengthening its service.

Another Sagar-Runi killing suspect gets bail

Govt to challenge the order at SC

The High Court yesterday granted ad-interim bail to Palash Rudra Paul, a suspect in the journalist couple Sagar Sarowar and Meherun Runi murder case, and issued a rule asking the government to explain why he should not get regular bail. Palash, who filed a petition seeking bail, was a security guard at the apartment building in the capital where the two were killed three years ago by "unidentified assassins". Assistant Attorney General Shahidul Islam Khan told The Daily Star that the bail order would remain in force till disposal of the rule, but the government would challenge the order at the Supreme Court. The same bench granted ad-interim bail to Tanvir Rahman, another suspect, on December 2 last year. Sagar, news editor of Maasranga TV, and his wife Runi, senior reporter of ATN Bangla, were slain at their rented flat on February 11, 2012. The next day, Runi's brother filed a murder case accusing unidentified people. So far police have arrested at least nine suspects.

FROM PAGE 3 Talking to The Daily Star, Moslem Uddin Ahmed, president of Chittagong south district unit AL, said they had come to know about this recently.

"We've discussed the matter with party leaders very seriously," he said, adding, "We have informed the police high officials and requested them to find the personnel leaking information." "When the law enforcers are trying to resist the bomb attackers with the help of people, these sorts of activities by some cops are making the whole task difficult," he said. ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury, president of Chittagong city unit of AL, said police officials were the servants of the state. "We have heard that some police personnel in Chittagong are leaking information to the BNP-Jamaat men who are conducting bomb attacks to kill innocent people." "We urge the police high officials to find them and take departmental action against them." Mohiuddin, however, said the law and order situation in Chittagong was better than the other parts of the country. He lauded police for this. "Most of the police officials are discharging their duties honestly here," he said.
