COMPLETING MARATHONS IN 7 CONTINENTS Buet alumni assoc greets Dr Tapantosh for his feat

The Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology Alumni Association yesterday felicitated Dr Tapantosh Chakrabarty for his achievement in completing marathons in all continents of the world.

Noted civil engineer Prof Jamilur Reza Choudhury said they were happy for Chakrabarty's achievement while giving a brief introduction on him.

The alumni association organised a reception at the university to felicitate distinguished alumni of the university.

Tapantosh, now 64, began running marathons at the age of 50. In the last 14 years, he participated in and completed 29 marathons in different parts of the world.

The last marathon he completed was held in Sydney last September, said Jamilur Reza Choudhury.

"Running marathons erased all mental and physical hardships I went through in my life," said Prof Tapantosh, who graduated in chemical engineering from BuET in 1972.

Indigenous girl 'raped' in Bandarban

A girl from the indigenous community was allegedly raped in Ruma upazila in Bandarban Wednesday night.

The victim alleged that two men picked her up from Ruma Bus Station around 7:00am on Wednesday promising to give her a ride to Ruma High School where she was headed.

Instead the men took her to Ruma Sangu bridge area and raped her, she claimed, adding that they left her there around 10:30pm. The eighth-grader has been admitted to Bandarban Sadar Hospital.

Shariful Islam, officer-in-charge of Ruma Police Station, said they arrested a man in this connection.

Man found dead in Barisal hotel room

A man was found dead in a hotel room in Barisal city yesterday where he had been staying since January 17.

Informed by Hotel Melody's staff, police recovered the body of Nizamul Islam, 54, of Barisal Sadar upazila, after opening the room which was locked from inside.

Police said there were no signs that violence was involved in the death and sent the body to Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

'JMB man' held in Mymensingh

Kotwali police arrested an alleged Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) activist with three crude bombs wrapped in a white paper in Shikarikaanda Belltoli bridge area in Mymensingh Sadar upazila yesterday.

During primary interrogation, Emdadul Haque Ujjal, 30, of Muktagachha upazila, confessed to his involvement with the banned Islamist outfit, said police. A Mymensingh court sent Ujjal to jail. A case was lodged.

Road crashes kill five, injure four

Five people were killed and four others injured in road accidents in the country yesterday.

Our Munshiganj correspondent reports, four people were killed and four others injured when a corn-laden truck tumbled onto a rickshaw and two CNG-run auto-rickshaws near Jamaldi bus stand on Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Gazaria upazila of Munshiganj. Two of the four dead were identified as Kalu Mian, 38, and Montu, 16.

Our Khulna correspondent adds, a battery-run auto-rickshaw driver, Nossu Matobbar, 50, of Khulna city, died after a truck of Zinnat Cargo Service hit the vehicle in Raily Gate area on Khulna-Jessore highway.

Police seized the truck but the driver escaped.

2 Pirojpur Hindu temples torched

Unidentified miscreants torched two Hindu temples at Kumarkhali village in Nazirpur upazila in Pirojpur early yesterday.

Chinmoy Majumdar said he saw fire coming out of the Kali Temple at his house around 2:00am. Locals doused the blaze.

The miscreants also set fire to nearby Ganges Temple. Nazirpur police visited the scene.

Khanom alleged that anti-liberation forces led by BNP-Jamaat-Islami were killing common people by setting them on fire in the name of agitation.

She urged the government to take legal action against the BNP-Jamaat leaders and activists to protect people's lives and property.

Another AL lawmaker, Sabina Akter Tuhin, said BNP's image had dropped far below that of Jamaat through the destructive activities. She observed that BNP had become an "underground political party" and the government should ban it. She also threatened to lay siege to the houses of BNP-Jamaat leaders and activists if the blockade was not withdrawn.

Eminent cultural personality Ramendu Majumder said BNP should withdraw their agitation programme keeping in mind the Secondary School Certificate examinations scheduled to begin on February 2. He added that the government has no way to retreat and has to prevent the violence with the use of force.

Ex-Information Commissioner Sadeka Halima demanded that a safe environment be ensured for all students, especially SSC examinees. Dhaka University's Prof Syed Anwar Hossain, World University Vice Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan Choudhury, journalist Abed Khan and Swadhin Bangla Betar singer Manoranjan Ghoshal also spoke.
