

ASK condemns blockade, crossfire deaths

Innocent bystanders dying and sustaining injuries in arson attacks during the ongoing blockade and hartals by BNP-led alliance is a cause for grave concern, said Ain o Salish Kendra in a press release yesterday.

At the same time, death of people in so-called crossfire by law enforcing agencies is equally worrisome, it added.

Death anniversary

Today is the 18th death anniversary of Dr AR Mallick, an eminent educationist and the first technocrat finance minister of Bangladesh.

He was a professor of South Asian Regional Studies at the University of Pennsylvania, USA and the founding vice chancellor of Chittagong University.

He was the president of the Liberation Council of Intelligentsia in 1971 and became the first education secretary and first high commissioner to India.

Writer of numerous books, he was also elected Asian Development Bank chairman.

On this occasion, food will be distributed at Bhashantek orphanage today.

Road crashes kill 7

Seven people died in road accidents in four districts yesterday.

In Chittagong, two people died as a covered-van dashed against a roadside tree on Chittagong-Dhaka highway in Mirsarai upazila. The deceased were the van driver, Omar Faruk Ahmed, 30, and his helper Sohag, 25, of Noakhali.

In Chittagong port area, Md Joyнал, 35, of Fakir Hat area in the city died as a covered-van hit him while he was crossing the road in front of Customs House.

In Barisal, two people died after a truck fell into a canal beside Barisal-Dhaka highway. The deceased were the trucker Nur Hosain Shikdar, 31, of Baufal and helper Zafar Rari, 26, of Patuakhali.

In Moulvibazar, Tasmima Begum, 7, daughter of Masuk Miah of Matia village died when an auto-rickshaw hit her in Ranirbazar area of Kamalganj upazila.

In Dinajpur, Naymun Nahar, 7, daughter of Sanwar Hossain of Shreemontopur, died when a tractor hit her in Khangarbazaar area of Panchbibi upazila of Joypurhat.

Earlier, Nazmul said he was stopped and his friend Shuvo was asked to get down from his motorcycle by police when he saw SI Mehedi Hasan himself violating the ban by carrying another man on his motor-bike.

The injured were rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital and later shifted to DU medical centre.

On Monday, Golam Mostafa, an assistant sub-inspector (ASI) of Ramna Police Station, was "closed" for his alleged involvement in torturing the reporter and his friend, but no steps were taken against SI Mehedi Hasan, who allegedly led the beating.

Poor new, expecting mothers to get aid

The government has taken up a new project to provide assistance to the poor mothers and pregnant women for ensuring better health of their children.

The Executive Committee of the National Economic Council yesterday approved the Tk 2,378 crore "Income Support Programme for the Poorest (ISPP)" project. The World Bank will bear 98 percent of the cost of the project.

Planning Minister AHM Mustafa Kamal said if mothers get proper nutrition they would give birth to healthier babies.

He said if the project is implemented, the nation would get a healthier and brighter generation.

Under the project, financial assistance will be electronically disbursed to the women's post office accounts.

Primarily, the project will be implemented in seven districts of Dhaka and Rangpur divisions where about five lakh
