Sony Pictures said today that it has picked up feature film rights to Descender, which debuts March 4 from Image Comics. The incredibly lifelike artificial boy, TIM-21, might hold the secrets deep in his machine DNA to the origin of robots that have decimated entire planets. IN DUBIOUS BATTLE Helmed By James Franco

The film is based on John Steinbeck's gritty, realist style novel In Dubious Battle, which portrays the struggle between labor and capital in 1930s America as close to all-out warfare. Writer Matt Rager (As I Lay Dying) adapted the feature screenplay based on the novel. Principal photography on the film will commence in March.
