## PROTECTING WILDLIFE Trawlers' passing thru Sundarbans banned

UNB, Bagerhat

In an effort to protect the wildlife and forest resources of the Sundarbans, the forest department has imposed a ban on plying of trawlers in the rivers and canals of the mangrove forest as these are widely used for poaching and smuggling of the wildlife.

The authorities of the Sundarbans--both east and west zones--clamped the ban

restricting the use of trawlers in any work in the forest, including fishing and transportation, until further order.

The forest department sources said the poachers enter the forest after taking permission from the department in the name of fishing and transportation of fish.

Later, they hunt tigers, deer and other wildlife setting traps or shooting them, the SEE PAGE 5 COL 3


