

**Shooter gun seized**

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) seized a shooter gun and a bullet from Panchbibi upazila of Joypurhat district on Monday night.  
However, none was arrested in this connection, said a Rab official.  
Acting on a tip-off, the elite force raided Taltoli village at around 9:30pm and recovered the arms and bullet from a nearby pond.  
A case was filed with Panchbibi Police Station in this connection, said Major Abdur Rahim of Rab-5.

**15 hurt in Meherpur AL infighting**

At least 15 people were injured as two factions of a local unit of Awami League (AL) clashed over formation of a committee of the unit in Mujibnagar upazila of Meherpur district on Monday night.  
According to party sources, the council of AL Mohajanpur union unit began at Kamorpur Bazar at around 5:30pm with Ziauddin Biswas, president of the party's Mujibnagar

upazila unit, in the chair.  
At around 6:30pm, two presidential aspirants--Gloam Mostafa and Nazur Rahman Nannu--locked in an altercation over their contribution to the party.  
At one stage, the supporters of the two swooped on each other, leaving at least 15 people from both sides injured.  
The rival groups vandalised the conference venue and used bamboo sticks during the clash that lasted for an hour. Senior leaders of AL

unazila unit brought the situation under control at around 7:30pm.  
Of the injured, Dobir Ali Master, 46, president AL Ward No-5 under Mohajanpur union, and activist Abdus Sattar, 44, were admitted to Meherpur General Hospital while the rest given first aid at the upazila health complex.  
Contacted, Abdur Rafiq Mollah, general secretary of AL Mujibnagar upazila unit, told this correspondent that they postponed the council of the unit.

**Housewife murdered, another commits 'suicide'**

A housewife was murdered while another allegedly committed suicide in Panchagarh and Jessore districts yesterday and the day before.  
In Panchagarh, a woman was strangled at Sonapatila village in Atwary upazila on Monday night, reports our Thakurgaon correspondent.  
The deceased was identified as Beauty Akhtar, 20, wife of Anwar Hossain of the village.  
Police and locals said Anwar Hossain, 22, son of Shafiqul Islam of the area, married Beauty three years ago.  
At around 10:00pm on Monday, Anwar and Beauty went to sleep in their room.  
Hearing screams, neighbours rushed to the spot at around 11:00pm and found her body lying on the bed.  
Being informed, police reached the house, recovered the body and sent it to Panchagarh Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.  
The law enforcers later arrested Anwar in connection with the incident, said police.  
The victim's father filed a case with Atway Police Station, accusing Anwar of killing her daughter.  
Away in Jessore, a housewife took her life following an altercation over family matter at Swarupur village in Chowgachha upazila yesterday.  
The deceased was identified as Nasrin Khatun, 20, wife of Babu Hossain of the area, reports our Benapole correspondent.  
Family sources said Nasrin committed suicide by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room.  
The body was sent to Jessore Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy, said police.

**2 bodies found in Rangpur**

Police recovered the bodies of a housewife and a youth from Pirganj upazila in the district yesterday and the day before.  
The deceased were identified as Sabirna Nechha, 30, wife of Bhuttu Mian of Chakdaria village under Sadullapur upazila in Gaibandha district, and Sohel Rana, 22, son of Afser Ali of Bogerbari village under Pirganj upazila.  
Police said villagers found the body of Sabirna beside a graveyard at Panbazar-Pashimpara village yesterday morning and informed the police who sent the body to Rangpur Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.  
The body bore several injury marks, said Md Israil Hossain, officer-in-charge of Pirganj Police Station.  
Meanwhile, locals found the body of Sohel at Barodaha village in Pirganj upazila on Monday morning and informed the police.  
The law enforcers then went to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to the hospital morgue for autopsy.  
A gang might have strangled him and dumped the body in the area, said the OC.

**Rapist gets life, stalker jailed for six months**

A rapist was sentenced to life imprisonment in Chandpur while a stalker jailed for six months in Munshiganj yesterday.  
In Chadpur, Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal sentenced a youth to life imprisonment for raping a teenage girl in Faridganj upazila of the district in 2011, reports our correspondent.  
The convict is Md Monir Hossain, 28, son of Sona Mian of Charpoa village in the upazila. He was tried in absentia.  
Judge Ramoni Ranjan Chakma also fined the convict Tk 50,000, in default he is to suffer six months

more in jail.  
According to the case statement, Monir intercepted the girl while she was going to a nearby house on the night of September 27, 2011. He forcibly took the girl to an orchard and raped her.  
Victim's father filed a case with Faridganj Police Station the following day, accusing Monir.  
After investigation, Sub-Inspector (SI) Nasir Uddin, also the investigation officer of the case, pressed charges against Monir on October 31, 2012.  
Our Munshiganj correspondent adds: A mobile court sentenced a youth to six months imprisonment for stalking a college girl in Tongibari upazila of the

district yesterday.  
The convict is Md Aminul Islam Hridoy, son of Manirul Islam of Dulihati village in the upazila.  
Locals said Hridoy used to tease the girl, a student of Tongibari BT College, on her way to and from the college.  
He along with three others tried to pick up the girl while she was going to the college in the morning. As she cried for help, locals rushed to the spot, caught the youth and handed him over to the police. His three accomplices, however, managed to flee.  
Police produced Hridoy before a mobile court led by Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Tazin Sarwar. After a hearing, the court punished the youth.

**21 petrol, crude bombs recovered**

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in a drive recovered 11 crude bombs from Debisingh area in Boalmari upazila early yesterday.  
Rab sources said, acting on a tip-off, a team of the elite force raided the area around 6:00am and recovered the bombs from in front of a shop. None was arrested in this connection.  
In Chuadanga, police in a drive recovered 10 petrol bombs and several bomb-making materials from Machherdaria area in the town early yesterday.  
On secret information, a team of the law enforcers conducted a drive and seized the bombs and the bomb-making materials from near a tea stall at midnight, said Munshi Asaduzzaman, officer in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

**FF NURUL ISLAM MURDER IN SHARIATPUR 2 main accused dropped from charge sheet**

Police have submitted charge sheet to a Shariatpur court in the case for killing freedom fighter Nurul Islam Matbor with an appeal for discharging two main accused.  
A group of people killed Nurul Islam Matbor at Paschim Nawardoba in Jajira upazila of Shariatpur district on September 30 last year, following a land dispute.  
The day after, the victim's eldest son Mozammel Haq Matbor filed a case with Jajira Police Station accusing 18 named people

including Jalil Gomosta and Alauddin Gomosta and 10 to 12 unnamed ones.  
Jalil and Alauddin were top two accused in the case but sub-inspector (SI) Sanjay Kumar Saha, investigating officer of the case, submitted charge sheet to a Shariatpur court on February 9, with a prayer to relieve the two persons from the case, victim's family members said.  
Jalil is now on bail while Alauddin has remained absconding.  
"In the charge sheet, police appealed to the court for relieving Jalil and Alauddin, two main accused


of the murder case. We suspect that they have collusion with the accused," plaintiff Mozammel told this correspondent yesterday.  
"The investigating officer secretly submitted the charge sheet to the court. We came to know about it from a source two days after the submission," he said, adding that the family members are now receiving threats from unknown callers.  
Contacted, SI Sanjay said the names of Jalil and Alauddin were dropped as police did not find their involvement with the murder.

**Two kids drown in ponds**

Two children drowned in ponds in Jessore and Panchagarh districts yesterday.  
In Jessore, a four-year-old boy drowned in a pond in Kharki area of the district town yesterday morning.  
The deceased was identified as Azimuddin, son of Arif Hossain of the area,

reports our Benapole correspondent.  
Locals said Azimuddin fell into the pond near their house while he was playing on its bank.  
Family members later rescued the boy from the pond and sent him to Jessore Medical College Hospital where the on-duty doctors declared him dead.  
Away in Panchagarh, a

baby girl drowned in a pond at Mullukchand village in Tentulia upazila the same day.  
The dead is Rima, 4 daughter of Abdur Rahim of the village, reports our Thakurgaon correspondent.  
Family sources said Rima accidentally fell into the pond near their house while she was playing on its bank in the afternoon.

**26 rescued from traffickers**

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) rescued 26 people, while they were being trafficked to India through Sadipur border point under Benapole Port Police Station yesterday morning.  
Lt Col Jahangir Hossain,

commanding officer of BGB-26 Battalion, said the border guards, acting on a tip-off, raided the area at around 6:00am and rescued 26 people, including 11 women and three children.  
The traffickers brought the people from Narail, Bagerhat and Faridpur dis-

tricts, BGB sources said, adding that none of the traffickers was arrested as they fled the scene, sensing the presence of the border guards.  
The victims were later handed over to Benapole Port Police Station, said Sub-Inspector Rafiqul Islam.
