Stop gambling, obscene dances at fair

Locals demand at human chain in Thakurgaon

A human chain was formed in front of Thakurgaon Press Club in the town yesterday, demanding immediate steps to stop obscene dances and gambling at a fair at Goalgari village in Baliadangi upazila.

Several hundred people, including journalists and lawyers, took part in the programme.

Addressing a rally at the venue, the speakers said a group of local people organised 'Ananda Mela' in the name of Baliadangi Upazila Unit of Muktiyoddha Sangsad.

The organisers continued holding the 15-day-long fair kicked off on

January 17, violating the order of local administration, they said.

They later submitted a memo to the home minister and the home secretary through Deputy Commissioner Mukesh Chandra Biswas.

Contacted, Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Md Sogir Hossain said they have already asked the organisers

to stop the fair.

Sohorab Ali, commander of the upazila unit of Bangladesh Muktiyoddha Sangsad, said a section of local people arranged the fair, using the name of the sangsad.

He urged the local administration to take necessary steps against the persons involved in such illegal acts.

212 maunds of jatka seized

Around 212 maunds of jatka (hilsa less than 10 inches long) were seized in separate drives in Chandpur and Munshiganj districts yesterday.

Our Chandpur correspondent reported that coastguards seized 110 maunds of jatka from a

passenger launch in the Meghna River in Mohanpur area under Matlab Uttar upazila at around 1:30am.

Lieutenant M Hamidur Rahman, commander of coastguard Chandpur station, said law enforcers raided Dhaka-bound MV Pubali from Sureshwar and seized the fish.

None, was, however arrested in this connection. The seized fish were later distributed among the orphanages and madrasas.

Away in Munshiganj, coastguards seized 102 maunds of jatka, raiding four passenger launches in the Dhaleshwari River near Munshiganj launch termi-

nal in the morning.

Coastguard officer Khalilur Rahman said the fish were seized from Dhaka-bound MV Gazi-4, MV Prince of Barisal-8, MV Morning Sun-2 and MV Pubali-1.

Later, the fish were distributed among the local orphanages and madrasas.

Fratricide

A man was killed allegedly by his younger brother over a family feud at Debinagar village in Sadar upazila yesterday.

The deceased is Firoz Hossain, 38, son of Ayazuddin of the village.

Police said there had been a longstanding conflict between Firoz and his younger brother Saddam Hossain, 35, over the ownership of a mango orchard.

As a sequel to the conflict, they engaged in an altercation around 10:00am. At on stage, both stabbed each other with knives. Firoz died on the spot while Saddam was admitted to Chapainawabganj Sadar Hospital in a critical condition.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to the morgue for autopsy, added the SI.

Electronics factory catches fire

A fire broke out at an electronics factory of Jamuna Group in Shafipur area of Kaliakoir upazila last night.

Fire service officials said the fire originated in the television

(TV) room at around 6:00pm and soon spread to all sections of the factory.

On information, 10 fire fighting units from Kaliakoir, Savar EPZ and Gazipur rushed to the spot and doused the blaze after three and a half hours of frantic efforts.

The extent of losses caused by the fire could not be ascertained immediately.

PROTESTING TOLL COLLECTION

Transport workers block Bogra-Naogaon highway

Transport workers yesterday blocked Bogra-Naogaon highway in Dupchanchia municipality protesting 'illegal' toll collection from vehicles and harassment of a fellow worker by a section of municipality employees.

The two hour long blockade from 10:00am added to

the sufferings to the commuters due to the ongoing countrywide non-stop blockade and frequent hartals enforced by BNP-led 20-party alliance.

A number of vehicles remained stranded on the highway due to the blockade called under the banner of Upazila Sammilito Sramik Oikya Parishad.

Mohidul Islam, president of Sammilito Sramik Oikya Parishad, said an employee of the municipality harassed one of their fellow workers yesterday as he protested realising of extra money in the name of toll collection.

They demanded immediate arrest of the accused employee and an end to the

toll collection in the name of development.

On information, police rushed to the spot and removed the barricades after assuring the demonstrators of taking action against the culprits, said Gopal Chandra Chakraborty, officer in charge of Dupchanchia Police Station.
