ADMISSION TO JU  
Demand for  
staff's ward  
quota protested  
by teachers,  
students

Teachers and students of Jahangirnagar University (JU) yesterday protested the university staff's demand to allow admission of 96 disqualified applicants under the ward quota. Under the banner of "Teacher-Student Unity Forum", teacher and students held a press conference on the campus and announced protest programmes to move against the staff's demand. The demonstrators also made a three-point demand, including a common policy for all admission seekers and removal of the vice chancellor's quota. They said they would form a human chain on the JU Shaheed Minar premises today to press home their demand and hand over a memorandum to Vice Chancellor Farzana Islam in this regard. Earlier, the university staff withdrew their movement for pressing home their demand after authorities concerned assured them of considering the request. Abdur Rahman Babul, secretary of JU Officers' Association, said they would begin demonstrating again from today if the authorities' answer is not favourable. The Central Admission Committee is to meet today to take a decision about the admission of disqualified applicants.

## Arrest warrants issued against three more

Third prosecution witness testifies over Binodpur murders

International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday issued a warrant following a petition filed by the prosecution for the arrest of three alleged Razakars in the war crimes case against two brothers of the same locality in Kishoreganj.

Meanwhile, a third prosecution witness testified before International Crimes Tribunal-2 over the torture and

murders, including that of his brother and two nephews, carried out in the Binodpur High School field in Chapainawabganj allegedly by Razakars Mahidur Rahman and Afsar Hossain alias Chutu during the 1971 Liberation War.

The tribunal-1 allowed investigators to interrogate one of the brothers, Shamsuddin Ahmed, 60, a Kishoreganj lawyer, at their "safe home" and fixed

March 30 for further orders. The other brother, Nasir Uddin Ahmed, 62, a former army officer, is on the run.

Of the three, Gazi Abdul Mannan was commander of Karimganj upazila unit of the Razakar Bahini, the Pakistani occupation army's auxiliary force, while Hafizuddin and Azharul Islam were members, Prosecutor Sultan Mahmud Simon told journalists.

The banner also had a question asking Khaleda the number of bodies she wanted while some flowers were placed underneath as a sign of respect to the victims.

"After seeing the list, she (Khaleda) might feel sad and withdraw the blockade and hartals," said Tarana. She, however, did not reply when asked for comments on victims of alleged extrajudicial killings during the period.

A larger group, including Pijush Bandyopadhyay, had initially headed towards the office in silence demanding immediate withdrawal of hartals and blockades but was stopped just yards away in front of Gulshan Model School and College by police.

The human chain, formed for around two hours from 10:30am and stretching some 50 yards into Kemal Ataturk Avenue, carried placards, banners and festoons containing slogans against violence, hartals and blockades.

The protesters, including cultural activists Syed Hasan Imam, Tushar Khan and Chanchal Chowdhury, using a megaphone, said Bangladesh was engulfed in criminal acts in the name of political programmes.

People do not want repetition of such violent and subversive acts in the name of hartal and blockade, they said.

Former foreign minister Dipu Moni said burning people could not be a part of politics and asked everyone to unite against it.

occurrences on a larger scale, said the ruling Awami League president, adding, "...because this situation cannot be tolerated...we have to protect the country's people."

Hasina said the BNP-Jamaat alliance did the same thing back in 2013 ahead of the last national election.
