

ICT DRAFT VERDICT LEAK CASE Hearing on charge framing deferred

COURT CORRESPONDENT

A Dhaka court yesterday adjourned till March 12 the hearing on charge framing against seven accused, including the wife and son of convicted war criminal Salauddin Quader Chowdhury, in a draft verdict leak case.

The case was filed against them for allegedly leaking the draft verdict of the International Crimes Tribunal-1 that sentenced Salauddin to death in October 2013.

Judge KM Shamsul Alam of Cyber Tribunal of Dhaka passed the order as Salauddin's wife Farhat Quader Chowdhury, now on bail, could not appear before it due to illness.

The other accused are: Salauddin's son Humam Quader Chowdhury, his manager Mahbul Ahsan, his lawyer Fakhrul Islam, the tribunal's office assistant Faruk Hossain and janitor Nayan Ali, and Fakhrul's assistant Mehedi Hasan.

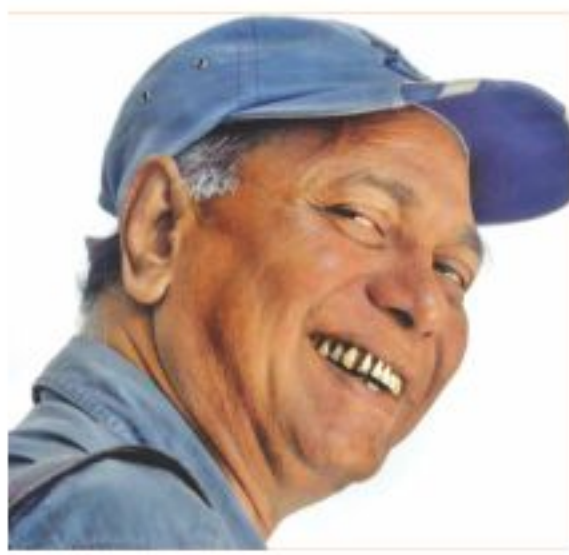
Humam is on bail, Mehedi is at large and the others are in custody.

In Dinajpur, Shuvo, 5, son of Aminul Islam of Chandpara village, died when a truck ran him over on Phulbari-Madila road on Monday.

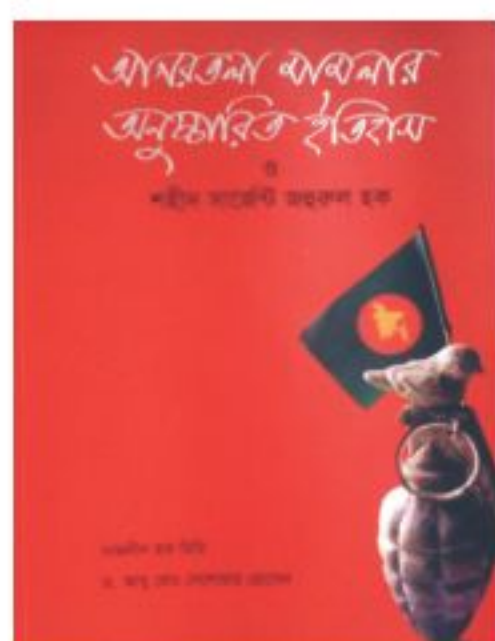

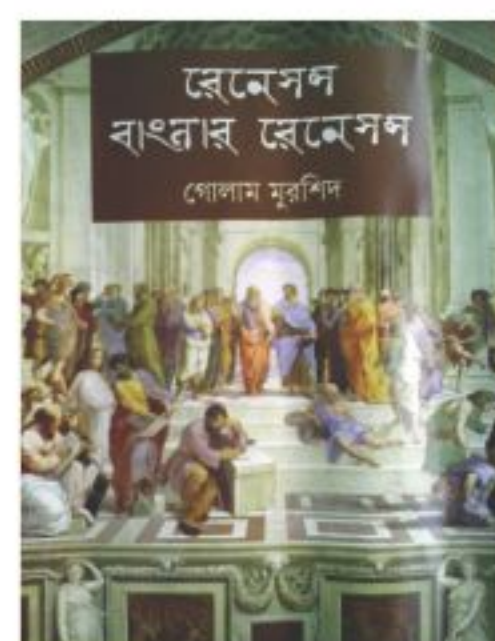

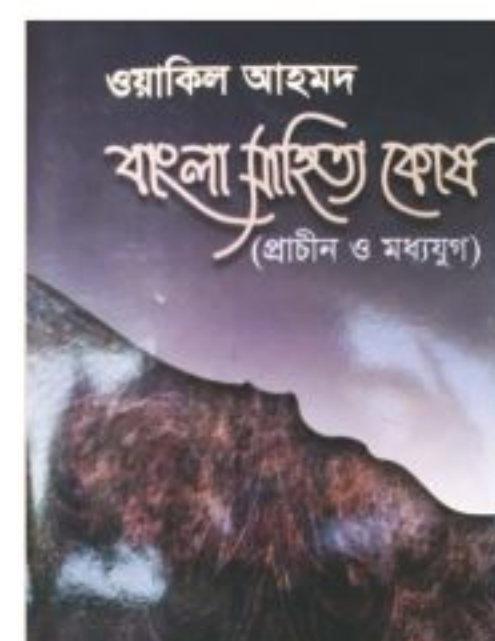

'IRREGULARITIES' AT CTG PORT JS probe committee dissatisfied with two projects *Wants procurement documents of last five years*

A parliamentary probe committee, during its investigation at Chittagong Port yesterday, asked the officials to submit documents of all purchases of over Tk 50 lakh in the last five years.

The committee also found some substandard equipment while visiting two projects -- Computerised Container Terminal Management System (CTMS) and Vessel Traffic Management Information System (VTMIS), confirmed the committee sources.

With the two, a total of six projects, including purchases of three container vessels, an excavator, an ambulance boat and a bay cleaner, which are currently being examined for alleged irregularities and corruption, involve around Tk 250 crore, the sources added.

When asked about the irregularities, CPA Chairman Rear Admiral Nizamuddin Ahmed said all the purchases were done in line with the Public Procurement Rules, 2008, and investigations would reveal the truth.

The committee also visited the Karnaphuli river's capital dredging site. They were in a meeting with Chittagong Port Authority officials till filing of this report last night.
