2 more arson victims die

Vehicles torched on eve of fresh hartal

Two victims of petrol bomb attacks died at Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday, raising the death toll in the violence that began since January 6 to 80.

On the 54th day of the nationwide blockade, several vehicles were set ablaze, bombs went off and there were arrests of Jamaat and Shibir activists and recovery of explosives.

A Shibir activist had his wrist blown off in a bomb blast in Gazipur.

As the BNP-led 20-party alliance's 72hour countrywide hartal starts from 6:00am today, the government moved today's SSC and its equivalent exams to March 14 (Saturday).

The tests would be held from 10:00am to 1:00pm, said Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid at a briefing in his Hare Road residence in Dhaka.

Another test, which was scheduled for

February 12, will be held on March 13 (Friday) from 9:00am to noon, while the exam slated for March 3 has been postponed. Its date would be announced later.

Shakil Ahmed, 18, died of his injuries three days after he was burnt by petrol bomb at Rupganj in Narayanganj yesterday. Sixty percent of his body was burnt.

Shakil and bus helper Yasin, 12, were sleeping inside a bus in front of Bismillah CNG Filling Station on the Dhaka-Sylhet highway in Sawghat around 3:30am when the criminals hurled a petrol bomb.

Shakil died at 3:30pm at the intensive care unit, said Partha Shankar Paul, residential surgeon of DMCH burn and plastic surgery unit. Kabir Hossain died at 3:30am due to

excessive bleeding. He had jumped off a truck that criminals firebombed Friday night, injuring his leg.

Violence architects must face trial

Says EU team's release after Bangladesh visit

An EU delegation in a statement yesterday said victims of violence in Bangladesh deserved proper justice and the perpetrators, whoever they were, must be identified, brought to justice, and should receive "a fair trial".

"There was a fruitful discussion on the importance of upholding the rule of law and respecting human rights as fundamental instruments for de-escalating political tensions," read the statement issued by the delegation at the end of its sub-groups meetings with the government.

Three sub-groups meetings were held on February 26-27 under the framework of the 2001 Cooperation Agreement -- Governance,

Human Rights and Migration, Trade and Development Cooperation in the city.

The discussions were open and constructive, said the delegation, adding that they exchanged views on a wide range of issues. **HUMAN RIGHTS**

At the outset of the sub-group meeting on Governance, Human Rights and Migration, the delegation raised a number of concerns about the current political situation. In particular, the need to protect the fundamental democratic rights of the people of Bangladesh was discussed in view of the recent incidents of blockade violence.

The sub-group also addressed the need to strengthen cooperation on democracy,

Top Putin critic shot dead

West condems murder; Putin pledges to nail Nemtsov killers

President Vladimir Putin yesterday vowed to bring the "vile" killers of Kremlin critic Boris Nemtsov to justice as Western leaders and Russia's opposition roundly condemned the drive-by shooting near the Kremlin walls.

Putin, who earlier blamed the assassination on foes trying to discredit the Kremlin, said in a message to Nemtsov's mother: "Everything will be done so that the organisers and perpetrators of a vile and cynical murder get the punishment they deserve,"

The 55-year-old former deputy premier who was a vocal critic of Putin, was shot in the back several times shortly before midnight Friday as he walked across a bridge a stone's throw from the Kremlin.

Hours later yesterday a steady stream of mourners, many



Kiwis edge out Aussies, India toy with UAE

New Zealand reached the World Cup quarterfinals with a nail-biting onewicket win over Australia in Auckland on Saturday while 5,500 kilometres



away in Perth, India destroyed the amateurs of the UAE by nine wickets. New Zealand carved out a fourth win in four games in Pool A but, in pursuit of just 152 and

sitting comfortably at 78 for one, the Black Caps were crippled by sudden stage-fright as their next eight wickets fell for just 68 runs with 40,000 fans at Eden Park on the edge of their seats.

But Kane Williamson (45 not out) smashed the winning runs with a mighty six off Pat Cummins from the first ball of the 24th over, having watched helplessly as Australia leftarm seamer Mitchell Starc wreaked havoc with a career-best six for 28.
