ULAB signs MoU with The State University of New York - Brockport

ULAB signed an MoU with the State University of New York - Brockport (SUNY Brockport) on January 7, 2015. Dr. Ralph Trecartin, Assistant Provost for International Education, signed on behalf of SUNY and Prof. Imran Rahman, ULAB Vice Chancellor, signed on behalf of ULAB.



ULAB and SUNY Brockport have agreed to establish and enhance educational links between the two institutions through both educational and academic exchanges. These exchanges include: mutually beneficial academic programs and courses; exchange of academic staff for purposes of teaching and research; joint research, lectures and training; exchange of students for study, research and internship; and

academic transfer agreements. Prof. HM Jahirul Haque, ULAB Pro Vice Chancellor; Lt Col Foyzul Islam, ULAB Registrar; Juditha Ohlmacher, ULAB Advisor for Communications and Students Affairs; and Rehnema Karim, SUNY Brockport faculty member, among others, attended the signing which took place in the Vice Chancellor's Suite of ULAB.

ULAB Adventure Club Reaches High-Altitude Himalayan Peak

Twenty-five members of the ULAB Adventure Club successfully reached the high-altitude glacial lake of Roopkund in Uttarakhand, India this September 2014. Notably, it was the first such large group from Bangladesh fully to complete the total 58 km of trekking in six days at high altitude without facing any serious injuries. The only other Bangladeshi team to go to Roopkund was in 1986.

According to Wikipedia, Roopkund (also known as Mystery Lake) is "famous due to hundreds of human skeletons found at the edge of the lake. The location is uninhabited and is at an altitude of about 5,029 metres (16,499 feet)."

Since its inception, ULAB Adventure Club has been exploring nature and its wonders. The club has explored some of the most remote areas of Bangladesh, among which dual and triple summit of the highest mountains of Chittagong Hill Tracks are the most significant ones. This



time the adventure experience was taken to a higher level by exploring the Himalayas.
