Teenage girl gang-raped in Khagrachhari

A teenage Chakma girl was gang-raped in Kabakhali area under Dighinala upazila of the district on Monday night.

Police yesterday arrested one of the alleged rapists, Mohammad Shahriar Sohel, president of Kabakhali union unit of Chhatra League, following a case filed by the victim's mother against four people with Dighinala Police Station.

Shahadat Hossain Titu, officer in-charge of the police station, quoted victim's family members as saying that a gang of four led by Sohel picked up the girl while she was returning home from a religious function at the upazila headquarters around 11:30pm.

They took her to a nearby tobacco field in Kabakhali

area and violated her there, the OC added.

After primary interrogation, the victim was sent to Khagrachhari Adhunik Sadar Hospital for medical test.

Meanwhile, in a press release issued yesterday, Iqbal Bahar and Mongsaprue Marma, president and general secretary of BCL district unit, said they decided to permanently expel Kabakhali union unit president Sohel for his alleged involvement in the incident and asked the Dighinala unit to take necessary steps in this regard.

Away in Jamalpur, police arrested an absconding accused in a dowry case from Farajipara village in Bakshiganj upazila of the district on Monday night, reports our correspondent.

The arrestee is Mosharaf Faraji, 34, son of Bodi Faraji of the village.

Four get life for killing schoolboy in Sirajganj

A Sirajganj court yesterday sentenced four people to life imprisonment for killing a schoolboy in Ullapara upazila of Sirajganj district in 2009.

The lifers are Abdus Salam, 26, son of Hazrat Pramanik, Rakibul Islam, 28, son of Ayan Sarkar, Jewel Ahmed, 30, son of Sohrab Ali, and Abdul Jabbar, 22, son of Yeasin Ali. They all are from Shumadhyamarich village in the upazila.

Judge Fazle Khoda Nazir of the Additional District and Sessions Judge's Court also fined the convicts Tk 20,000 each, in default, they are to suffer six months

more in jail.

The court acquitted two other accused as charges brought against them could not be proved.

According to the prosecution, the convicts stabbed Hasmat Ali, 15, a class X student of Bogra Dakhil Madrasa, to death on December 10 in 2009 following rivalry over a love affair with a girl of the village.

Aynal Haque, father of the deceased filed a murder case with Ullapara Police Station on the following day, accusing six people.

After investigation, Abdul Bari, sub-inspector of the police station, submitted the charge-sheet to the court.

Housewife found dead

Police recovered the body of a housewife at Kumarkhali village in Shirajdikhan upazila yesterday.

The deceased is Nazmim Akhter, 20, wife of Monir Hossain, an expatriate in Brunei, of the village. She was mother of five-year-old girl.

The family members of Monir alleged that Nazmim took her life by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room on Monday night.

However, Abdul Awal, father of the deceased, alleged that Nazmim's in-laws killed her over family feud and hanged the body from the ceiling to pass it off as a suicide.

On information, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Munshiganj General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Yeardous Hasan, officer-in-charge of Shirajdikhan Police Station, they are investigating the incident.

Seven bombs, pistol seized

Police seized seven bombs from Kajla village in Jhikargachha upazila of Jessore district yesterday afternoon.

Shahidul Islam, officer-in-charge of Chougachha Police Station, said a police team, acting on a tip-off, went to the village at around 3:30pm and seized the bombs from a field.

Meanwhile, members of Border Guard Bangladesh seized a pistol, two bullets and two magazines from Kagojpur under Benapole Land Port Police Station early yesterday.

On secret information, the border guards raided the area and seized the firearm and bullets.

84 tolas of gold seized, one arrested

Police arrested an alleged smuggler and seized 84 tolas of gold from his possession in Kotchandpur upazila of the district early yesterday.

The arrestee is Jasim Uddin, son of Haji Nur

Mohammad of Gobindal village in Singair upazila of Manikganj district.

Acting on a tip-off, a police team raided a Chuadanga-bound passenger bus from Dhaka in front of Kotchandpur Police Station around 5:00am and arrested Jasim along with the gold, said Shahidul

Islam Shahin, officer-in-charge of the police station.

A case was filed with the police station in this connection.

On March 4, police arrested two smugglers along with 90 tolas of gold from the bus stand area of the upazila town.

Criminals fell 300 karalla plants in Jhalakathi

Criminals cut around 300 karalla (balsam apple) plants at a farm of Charkeota in Rajapur upazila under the district on Monday night.

"I was shocked to see my ravaged karalla garden today [Tuesday] morning. I informed other farmers and the local agriculture office," said Nizam Khan, who raised the garden on a half-acre land.

"After leasing the land for

Tk 10,000 last year, I with my wife grew karalla plants there and earned a profit of Tk 70 thousand," said Nizam, a landless farmer.

"We planted 400 karalla plants three months ago and the plants started yielding recently. I have already sold karalla worth Tk 15,000 from the farm this week. I expected to make a profit of Tk 1.5 lakh by selling the vegetable this season as it has good demand in the market but the miscreants

dashed all my hopes.

"Usually I guard my farm every night but on Monday night I was busy at the house. Seeing my success, many other farmers were encouraged to do similar farming but now they are worried too," said Nizam.

Terming such incident as a threat for innovative agriculture, Rajapur Upazila Agriculture Officer Md Riaz Ullah Bahadur said they will extend possible help to the farmer to recoup the loss.

Five shops gutted

Five shops were gutted in a fire at Katherpool Masjid Market in the district town early yesterday. Youth electrocuted

A youth was electrocuted at Bhayna intersection in the district town yesterday morning. The deceased was identified as Rafiqul Islam, 28, son of Rabiul Islam of Mirzapur village in Sadar upazila. Jahangir Alam, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station, said Rafiqul came in contact with a live electric wire while he was doing electrical work inside a building in the area. He was taken to Magura Sadar Hospital where the doctors declared him dead, said the OC.

Mobile shop looted

Criminals looted cash and other valuables from a mobile shop after stabbing its owner at Baghachra Bazar in Sharsha upazila on Sunday night. The injured is Rafiqul Islam, 35, son of Sheikh Nur Mohammad of Raripukur village. He was admitted to a local clinic. Police and witnesses said a gang swooped on the shop at around 9:00pm and stabbed Nur Mohammad indiscriminately, leaving him injured. They then took away Tk 2 lakh and some mobile phones sets, said Bayezid Ahmed, sub-inspector of Baghachra Police Outpost.

Death threat to FF

A freedom fighter (FF) of Chunarughat upazila in Habiganj district on Monday received death threat. The victim is Abdul Mutalib, a resident of Ikortoli village. The FF said "A gang of 2/3, led by one Chanchal Miah, 20, son of Abdul Ahad of the village, entered my house at night and threatened me with death as I gave deposition against war criminal Syed Kawsar," said the victim.
