KHAGRACHHARI, LAXMIPUR Schoolteacher, Jubo Dal leader murdered

A schoolteacher was killed and his wife seriously injured in an attack by criminals in Pashchim Keyangghat area under Mahalchhari upazila of the district early yesterday.

The deceased is Milon Bikash Chakma, 55, a resident of the area. He was an assis-

tant teacher of Nimna Kandalchhari Government Primary School in Naniarchar upazila of Rangamati district.

Injured Birlata Chakma, wife of Milon, was admitted to Khagrachhari Adhunik Sadar Hospital, said police.

A gang stormed into the house of Milon at around 1:00am and hacked the duo when they were asleep. The

schoolteacher died on the spot.

On information, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to the hospital morgue for autopsy, said Somoyan Kabir, officer-in-charge of Mahalchhari Police Station.

They are trying to unearth the clue behind the murder, said the OC.

Away in Noakhali, a local Jubo Dal leader was found murdered at Tin Rastar More near Deleyai Bazar in Chhatkhil upazila yesterday morning, reports our correspondent.

Son of Md Mokbul Hossain of Kanshipur village under Bashikpur union in Laxmipur district, deceased Md Israfil, 28, was the president of ward No 9 union of Jubo Dal under the union.

He was also the joint convener of the party's union unit, said advocate Harun Bepari, organising secretary of Laxmipur district unit of BNP.

Locals found the body in the area and informed police, said Md Abul Khair, officer-in-charge of Chhatkhil Police Station.

The body bore several marks of injuries caused by sharp weapons, said the OC.

Arrest warrant against ex-minister Milon

A Chandpur court yesterday issued arrest warrant against former state minister for education ANM Ehsanul Haque Milon and his wife Nazmun Nahar Baby in a case for vandalising vehicles in the district in 2003.

Judge Md Ataur Rahman of the Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court passed the order in the afternoon as they have been skipping the court for long.

According to the case statement, Milon and his wife and their supporters swooped on a procession brought out by Mohiuddin Khan Alamgir, former state minister for planning, and

other AL leaders in Sachar area of the town on October 16 and 17 in 2003.

At one stage, they took away cash and gold necklaces from vanity bags of the women AL leaders and vandalised vehicles.

On May 6 in 2009, Md Kalim Ullah filed the case with Kachua Police Station against Milon and his wife and others.

At least 31 cases were filed against Milon with different police stations and courts. He was arrested on March 14, 2010. The following year, he was released on bail.

Milon is now staying in Saudi Arabia for performing Omrah, said his lawyer Kamrul Islam.

Abducted youth rescued, 2 held

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab-13) rescued a youth from Gobindganj upazila of the district on Wednesday night, a day after his abduction from Bogra town.

The elite force members also arrested two abductors, Masud Rana Manik, 26, and Majnu Mia, 23, of Chawk Rahimapur village in the upazila.

Rab sources said a gang picked up Rakib Uddin, 30, a resident of Akkelpur upazila of Joypurhat district, from Satmatha area in Bogra town around 5:00pm on Tuesday.

Later, the kidnappers phoned the family members over the victim's mobile and

asked them to send Tk 3 lakh though a bKash number for his release.

After receiving the amount on Tuesday night, the gang again phoned the family on Wednesday morning and demanded Tk 3 lakh more for release of Rakib.

Finding no alternative, victim's nephew GM Hakim Uddin filed a General Diary with Akkelpur Police Station and also informed Rab-13 of the matter.

At around 8:00pm on Wednesday, a team of Rab-13 conducted a drive at Daridaha village in Gobindganj upazila by tracking the victim's phone number.

They rescued Rakib and arrested Manik and Manju from the village.

11 arrested while going to India illegally

Members of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) detained 11 Bangladeshi nationals while they were going to India illegally through Puthkhal border under Benapole Port Police Station on Wednesday night.

Acting on a tip-off, a patrol team of the border guards went there around 10:00pm and arrested 11 people, who were crossing the border without valid documents, said Tajul Islam, sub-inspector of Benapole Port Police Station.

The arrestees are from Barisal and Gopalganj districts.

They were later handed over to Benapole Port Police Station. A case was filed against them, the SI added.

Meanwhile, two Bangladeshi girls returned home after serving jail terms in India.

Indian police handed them over to the Bangladeshi immigration police at Benapole check post. The returnees hail from different villages in Digholia upazila of Khulna.

Moniruzzaman, officer-in-charge of Benapole check post immigration police, said the girls went to India in search of better jobs.

Police arrested them from an Indian town and sent them to jail through a court.

'GUNFIGHT' WITH POLICE

Robber gang leader killed in Sundarbans

An alleged leader of a robber gang was killed in a "gunfight" with police in Hongshu Rajerchar area of the Sundarbans early yesterday.

The deceased, Hasan Ali Sana, 32, son of Alim Sana, was the second-in-command of infamous Ranga Bahini, police said.

Acting on a tip-off, law enforcers conducted a drive in Dabura area of Shyamnagar upazila in Satkhira on Wednesday night and arrested Sana.

He was handed over to

Koyra police around 11:00pm.

After gleaning information from Sana, a police team taking him along with them launched a drive in Hongshu Rajerchar area around 2:00am to recover arms.

Sensing presence of the law enforcers, Sana's cohorts opened fire in a bid to snatch him, forcing the police members to retaliate by firing.

The gunfight left Sana, a resident of no 4 Koyra village in Koyra upazila, critically injured by bullets.

He was rushed to Koyra

Upazila Health Complex where doctors declared him dead.

Three policemen were also injured in the gunfight. Police recovered three shutter guns and 10 cartridges from the spot.

Harendranath Sarkar, officer-in-charge of Koyra Police Station, confirmed the incident.

Sana was wanted in robbery cases filed with different police stations, the OC added.

The body was sent to Khulna Medical College Hospital morgue for an autopsy.
