Eelectricity for all by 2021

The government has undertaken a number of projects to generate 20,000 megawatt (MW) of electricity aiming to provide power to all citizens by 2021 at a reasonable price.

"The Awami League-led government has achieved successes in the power sector in the past six years and our capacity to generate power more than double," an official of power, energy and mineral resources ministry told the news agency yesterday.

He said electricity generation capacity reached 11,265MW from 3,268MW in 2009, with around 68 percent of the population having access to electricity.

The official further said, "The government has given top priority to the development of the sector considering its importance in the overall development of the country."

According to the ministry sources, the government is expecting to generate 13,301MW of power at the end of this year.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina-led government has a target to generate 20,000MW of electricity by using 53 percent coal as primary energy within 2021, sources said.

They said the government has increased the number of power plants, transmission lines and distribution lines with an aim to foster the economic growth and become a middle income country by 2021.

Besides, solar home systems have been installed in the country's remote areas for meeting individual power demand.

Ending violence against women Coordinated efforts a must

Speakers at a high-level side event at the multi-sector programme addressing violence against women at the UN have underscored the need for coordinated effort of the national and international communities to stop such crimes.

The side event was organised by the Permanent Mission of Bangladesh to the UN on Thursday on the occasion of the ongoing 59th session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) at the UN, according to the news agency.

State Minister for Women and Children Affairs Meha Afroze Chumki, Permanent Secretary of Women Affairs Ministry of Zimbabwe Dr Perpetua Gumbo, Deputy Permanent Representative of Denmark Erik Laursen, Regional Director for Asia and the Pacific of the UN-Women Roberta Clarke and global gender equality adviser of Plan International Sarah Hendriks were present at the event as panellists.

Representatives of government agencies of various countries, women's rights groups, NGOs, media personnel and elected representatives participated in the event.

The state minister said violence against women is a common phenomenon across the world and it leaves devastating consequences on victims, their families and societies and impedes the potential of the society and the world as a whole.

A short video on activities of the multi-sector programme on violence against women in Bangladesh was presented in the event. The speakers said the political will that Bangladesh is showing to combat violence against women and children is commendable.

Division too, before it got 10 additional judges on February 9, raising the total number of HC judges to 97.

Court sources say the High Court usually disposes of 260 cases a day.

In January, Law Minister Anisul Huq told The Daily Star that the government planned to appoint new judges into both divisions but did not specify the number and time.

Earlier, in December 2014, he had said both divisions would get new judges by January.

The same problem plagues the lower courts too. Currently there are 1,700 judges, and the Law Commission recommended in September last year appointment of 3,000 more, if the government wants to reduce backlogs and bestow justice.
