Division too, before it got 10 additional judges on February 9, raising the total number of HC judges to 97.

Court sources say the High Court usually disposes of 260 cases a day. In January, Law

Minister Anisul Huq told The Daily Star that the government planned to appoint new judges into both divisions but did not specify the number and time.

Earlier, in December 2014, he had said both divisions would get new judges by January.

The same problem plagues the lower courts too. Currently there are 1,700 judges, and the Law Commission recommended in September last year appointment of 3,000 more, if the government wants to reduce backlogs and bestow justice.


