



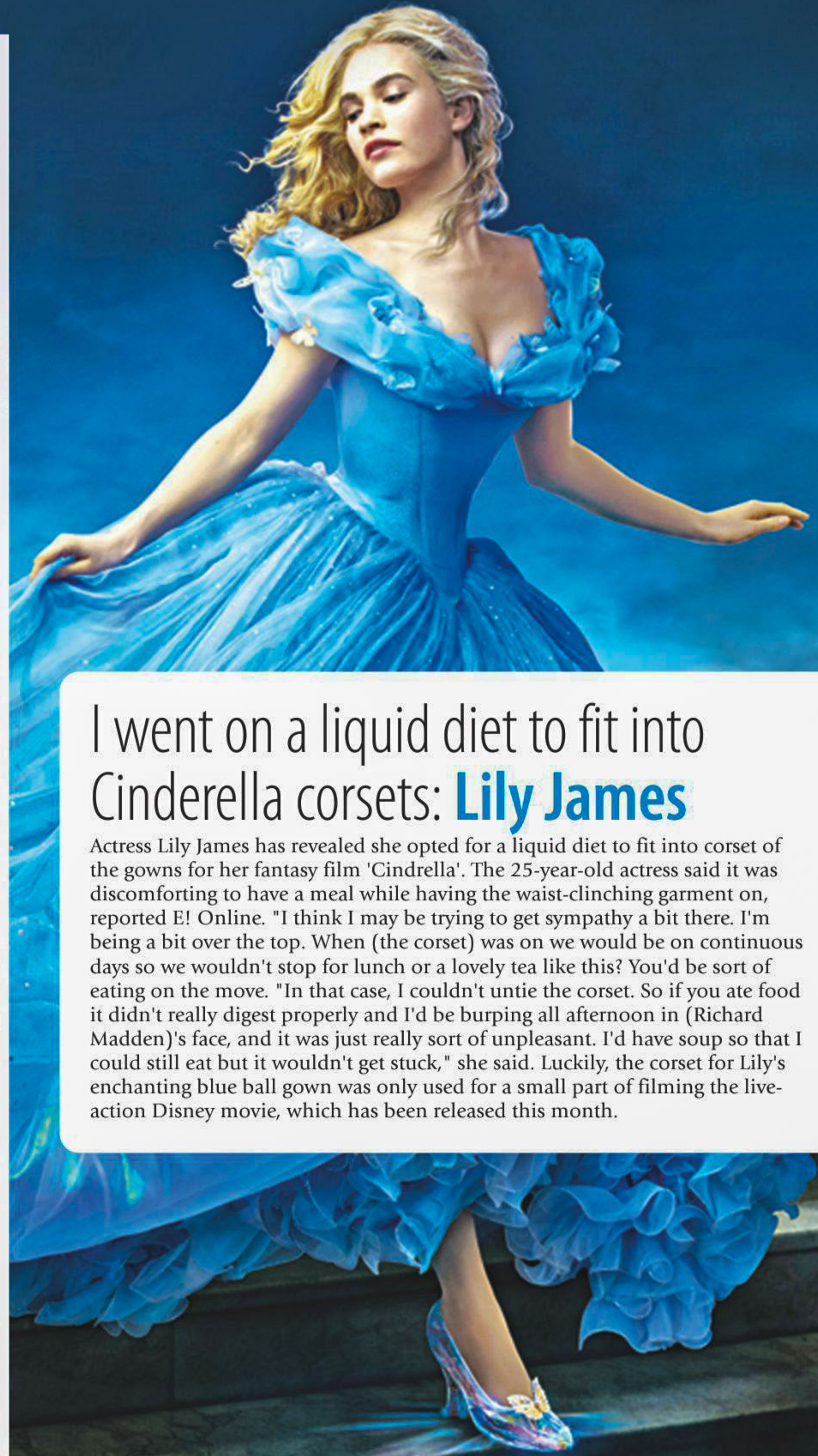
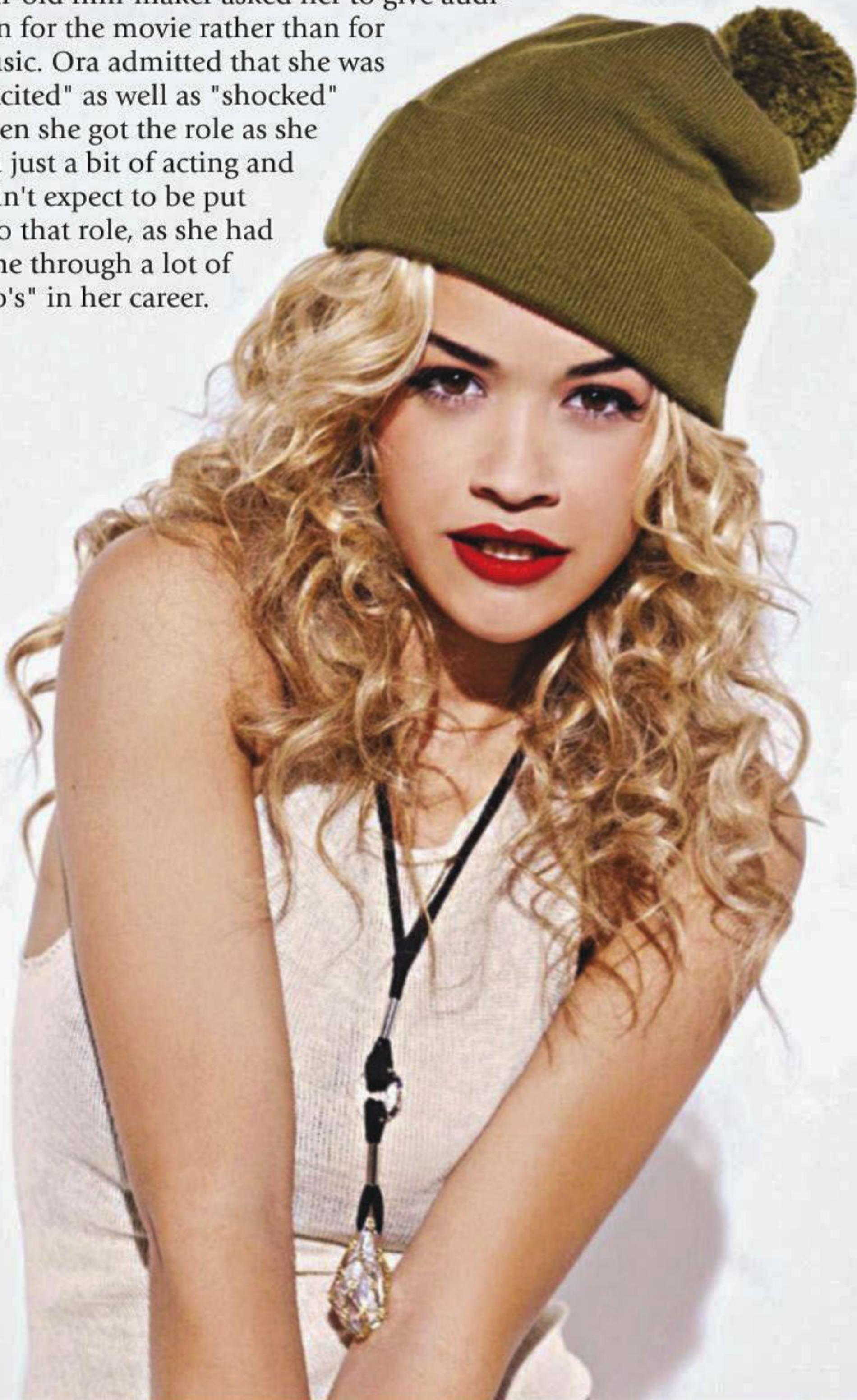
Invisible Emraan Hashmi in impressive 'Mr X' trailer!
