Abducted minor girl, schoolboy rescued

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in a drive rescued a three-year-old girl of Feni district from Chittagong yesterday, a day after her abduction.

They also arrested one Shariful Islam, a relative of victim Tasrifia Jamal Shimran, daughter of Md Jamal Uddin of Uttar Mandia village in Chhagalnaiya upazila in connection with the abduction, reports our Feni correspondent.

Marjina Akhter Poly, mother of the girl, said a gang picked up her daughter from their house on Wednesday afternoon and took her to an unknown place.

The kidnapers demanded Tk 10 lakh ransom from the family for her release, said Md Rashed Khan Chowdhury, officer-in-charge of Chhagalnaiya Police Station.

Following a complaint filed by Poly, a team of Rab-7 raided Masterpara area under Bhujpur Police Station in Chittagong yesterday morning and rescued the girl from a house.

The elite force also arrested Shariful from the spot. However, two other kidnapers—Md Nabi and Md Lokman—managed to flee the scene, said the OC.

Meanwhile, police rescued an abducted schoolboy from Shimulia ghat at Louhajang upazila of Munshiganj district yesterday afternoon, reports our correspondent.

The victim is Mahsin Munshi, 10, son of Shikander Munshi of Pashchim Nawduba village in Jajira upazila of Shariatpur, and a Class IV student of Majidkandi Government High School in the area.

A gang picked up Mahsin on his way to school in the morning, said family sources.

The family members then informed police about the matter.

When a launch reached Mawa ghat at around 12:30pm, the boy started crying, said Assistant Sub-Inspector Abul Kalam of Louhajang Police Station.

Kalam rushed to the spot and rescued the boy.

Two killed in clash over gambling in Habiganj

Three cops among 45 injured

Two people were killed and at least 45 others, including three cops, were injured in a clash between two groups of villagers over sharing the money collected from gambling spot on the bank of Sutang River in Lakhai upazila of Habiganj district on Wednesday evening.

The deceased are Hadiza Begum, 50, wife of Modhu Mia of Ashera village in Sadar upazila, and Rafiq Uddin, 35, son of Helal Uddin of Korab village in Lakhai upazila of the district.

Of the injured, three constables, Masud Rana, 23,

Hasan, 25, and Sajib Talukder, 22, of Lakhai Police Station, were admitted to Habiganj Sadar Hospital, said Mozammel Haque, officer-in-charge of the police station.

Locals arranged the gambling on the bank of the river where a day long annual fair of Hindus was held.

Police quoted locals as saying that the two groups—one from Ashera village and the other from Korab village locked in an altercation over sharing of money collected from the gambling spot around 6:00pm.

At one stage, they attacked each other with

sharp weapons and exchanged several gunshots that left 47 people, including three constables, injured.

Of the injured, Hadiza died at Habiganj Sadar Hospital while Rafiq on way to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital. The rest of the injured were admitted to Habiganj Sadar Hospital and Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital.

On information, police rushed to the spot and fired several rounds of tear-gas shells and rubber bullets to bring the situation under control, said Nazim Uddin, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

ILLEGAL RECRUITMENT OF TEACHER

Show cause notice issued to headmaster

The district education officer (DEO) yesterday issued a show cause notice to the headmaster of Bhelbari High School in Aditmari upazila under the district for illegally recruiting a teacher and asked the school managing committee (SMC) to take legal action in this regard.

Without maintaining the stipulated process including discussing the matter in the SMC meeting, advertisement for the post, and consulting with the teachers, the headmaster recruited one Ferdousi Begum as teacher, said school teachers and SMC members.

The headmaster submit-

ted a letter to the district education office seeking Monthly Payment Order (MPO) in favour of the 'newly recruited' teacher a month ago, said DEO officials.

The DEO visited the school last week and learnt that the SMC members and teachers of the school were totally unaware about the recruitment.

Confirming the matter, Lalmonirhat DEO Moslem Uddin said, "I have served a letter to the school managing committee to take legal step against the guilty headmaster by a week. If they fail to do so, I will write to the director general of the education directorate."

Talking to this correspondent, several teachers

said they did not know the newly recruited female teacher as she never came to school.

All the 22 assistant teachers of the school are demanding removal of the headmaster as he has been doing malpractice for long, they said.

"The school headmaster made the recruitment illegally, without informing me and other members of the committee. We will take legal step against the guilty headmaster after an SMC meeting within three days," said Akkas Miah, president of the SMC.

Contacted, headmaster Anisul Haque declined to talk with the journalist in this regard.

Elephants kill one, injure three

A man was killed and three other were injured by wild elephants in Sadar upazila of the district on Wednesday night.

The deceased was identified as Abul Kashem, 60, of Kadukhola village in the upazilla, said locals.

The injured are Mamtaj Uddin, 40, Zakir Hossain, 35, of the village, and a local journalist, Jamir Uddin, 32.

A herd of wild elephants entered the village from nearby reserve forest around 7:00pm and swooped on the villagers, leaving Kashem dead and three others injured, said Ranglaj Mro, chairman of Sadar Union Parishad.

Man killed over land dispute

A man was killed and four others were injured in an attack by rivals over a land dispute in Alamdanga upazila of Chuadanga district yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Ashraf Ali, 37, son of Yasef Mandol, of Hossainpur in the upazilla.

Injured Akmol Hossain, 36, Biplob Ali, 25, Idrish Ali, 30, and Lion Mollah, 36, of the area, were admitted to the upazilla health complex.

There was a longstanding conflict between one Rezaul and Hannan of the village over a piece of land, said Mamunur Rashid, officer-in-charge of Alamdanga Police Station.

As a sequel to the conflict, a group of supporters, allegedly led by Rezaul, equipped with lethal weapons attacked the men of Hannan, leaving Ashraf dead on the spot and four others injured.

A case was filed with Alamdanga Police Station.

No one was arrested in connection with the incident as of filing of this report at 5:00pm yesterday.

Police said they are raiding different areas to arrest the attackers.
