

# WAR CRIME TRIALS 4th person accuses Hasan of shooting FF's father

Says he tortured her father; another testimony recorded in Siraj Master case; contempt petition against Tajul, 5 Jamaat-Shibir leaders adjourned till April 5; investigation officer in Mahidur and Afsar's Chapainabganj war crimes case says he found criminal evidence against them

A fourth person yesterday testified that war crimes accused Syed Hasan Ali shot dead her cousin Tofazzal Hossain and tortured her father in Kishoreganj on August 23, 1971 accusing their sons of being freedom fighters of the Liberation War. International Crimes Tribunal-1 also recorded the testimony of Press Institute of Bangladesh Assistant Cataloguer Rabiul Alam in the war crimes case against three alleged Bagerhat Razakars - Sheikh Sirajul Haque alias Siraj Master, Khan Akram Hossain and Abdul Latif Talukder. It adjourned until April 5 hearing of a contempt petition against Tajul Islam, a counsel of war criminal ATM Azharul Islam, and five leaders of Jamaat-e-Islami and pro-Jamaat student organisation Islami Chhatra Shibir for their statements before the media after a verdict.

Meanwhile, the investigation officer of another war crimes case testified that Mahidur Rahman and Afsar Hossain alias Chutu were directly and indirectly involved in killings, mass killing, arson and other crimes against humanity in a bid to annihilate freedom fighters, pro-liberation people, Awami League men and Hindus.

**HASAN'S CASE**  
Local Razakars, the Pakistani occupation army's auxiliary force, had informed Razakar commander Hasan Ali of Tofazzal's son Shahjahan Bhuiyan and her brother Kamruzzaman going to India for training, said Mahfuza Akter, 61.

The 23rd prosecution witness told the three-member

# TAZREEN FIRE Court directs CID to probe disappearance of worker

COURT CORRESPONDENT

A Dhaka court yesterday directed the Criminal Investigation Department for further investigation into the disappearance of a garment worker in the Tazreen Fashions fire in November 2012.

Rehena Begum, who worked at the finishing section of Tazreen Fashions Ltd, has been missing since the fire on November 24.

Senior Judicial Magistrate Kazi Shahidul Islam passed the order after Rehena's brother Abdul Matin filed a no-confidence petition against the police report in this connection.

The court also asked CID's Senior Assistant Superintendent of Police Monsur Ali Mondol to submit a probe report to it by April 22.

On September 23 last year, Md Azharul Islam Sarkar, officer-in-charge of Ashulia Police Station, submitted a probe report.

# Road crashes kill five, injure one

Five people were killed and another was injured in road accidents in four districts yesterday and Saturday.

In Habiganj, two unidentified people died as a pickup-van hit their motorcycle near Highway Inn Hotel on Dhaka-Sylhet highway in Madhabpur upazila on Saturday.

In Chittagong city, Naima Tarannum, 10, died and her father Abu Nayeem of Double Mooring area was injured when a covered-van hit a motorcycle in Dampara area yesterday.

In Bhola, Mohammad Hasnain, 5, son of Farukh Munsif of Rasulpur village died when a three-wheeler hit

him on South Aicha-Shashivuson road in front of Shashibhushan Police Station in Charfasson upazila yesterday.

In Jhenidah, Ashraful Islam, 22, of Jhenidah Sadar died when a truck hit a three-wheeler carrying him at Bakulia under Kaliganj upazila on Saturday.

The survey, citing UN findings, said around 62 percent of the Bangladesh population live in informal settlements, surviving on informal work like housekeeping, plying rickshaws and auto-rickshaws for hire, manual labour, masonry, hawking and vending tea.

Citing the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics, it said Bangladesh's urban population was growing at a rate of three percent annually as a result of rapid urbanisation and economic opportunities. Simultaneously, urban poverty is increasing with over 21 percent of the urban population living in poverty.

A number of them present at the workshop said they were held hostage by slumlords with powerful political connections while local public representatives spoke for musclemen controlling the slums.

"We pay our slumlords Tk 1,600 per month for a 65-square foot of space to live with family, buy drinking water and electricity and pay for shared latrine," said Kulsum Begum from the Beltoli slum in Kalyanpur.

There remains no penny to finance the education of children, said Kulsum, a domestic help.

An IDS fellow, Dr Dolf te Lintelo, and Salma A Shafi, a renowned architect, town planner and honorary treasurer of the Centre for Urban Studies, spoke among others while M Hafiz Uddin Khan, former adviser to a caretaker government and currently treasurer of ActionAid Bangladesh, chaired the workshop.
