Detectives yesterday disclosed the arrest of six people involved in murdering and dismembering a woman, a day after the prime accused in the case was killed in a "shootout" with Rab.

Detectives claimed Sumi's husband Nasir, a cohort of Monty, was given one year imprisonment by a mobile court for Yaba trading.

"They killed Sumi as she threatened to hand them over to police," said Monirul.

Two of the arrestees -- Sujan and Suman alias Totla Suman -- were arrested on Sunday night in Gopibagh area. The same day Monty was killed in the "shootout" near Kamalapur Railway Station.
