

# DISMEMBERING OF WOMAN IN CAPITAL DB produces arrested six to media

Detectives yesterday disclosed the arrest of six people involved in murdering and dismembering a woman, a day after the prime accused in the case was killed in a "shoot-out" with Rab.

Police said all six were involved in Yaba trading with Mobarak Ullah Monty, the prime accused.

Eight people in total were involved in the murder of Sumi in Fakirapul of the capital on March 10, said Monirul Islam, joint commissioner of Detective Branch of Dhaka Metropolitan Police, at a press briefing at DMP media centre.

They tortured Sumi before killing her and dismembering her body around 2:30am, he added.

Detectives claimed Sumi's husband Nasir, a cohort of Monty, was given one year imprisonment by a mobile court for Yaba trading.

"They killed Sumi as she threatened to hand them over to police," said Monirul.

Two of the arrestees -- Sujan and Suman alias Totla Suman -- were arrested on Sunday night in Gopibagh area. The same day Monty was killed in the "shootout" near Kamalapur Railway Station.

While talking to The Daily Star at the press briefing, Sujan said they had no enmity with Sumi but they killed her as she had a feud with Monty.

The other four -- Saidul Islam, Hanif, Ratul Ahmed, Nurunnabi Shawon -- were arrested on different days. They have already confessed before a Dhaka court, said the detectives.

Police did not disclose arrest of the four as they had not caught Monty then, said a DB official preferring anonymity.

Meanwhile, Rab detained a man named Jahangir Hossain alias Sohel alias Bangla Sohel on Saturday.

Monirul said they know that the last person involved in the murder is a man named Sohel but they are not sure if the Sohel Rab arrested and the Sohel they are looking for is the same person.
