

# JUBO LEAGUE LEADER RANJU MUDER CASE Two accused arrested in Bogra town

Police arrested two accused in Jubo League leader Ranju Pramanik murder case, raiding Palsha area in Bogra town on Monday.

The arrestees are Touhidur Rahman Likhon, 21, son of Aminur Rahman Shahin, and Farhad Hossain Fuad, 35, son of late Abdus Sattar of Phultola area under Shahjahanpur upazila of the district.

Acting on a tip-off, a police team led by

Additional Superintendent of Police Arifur Rahman Mondol raided a students' mess in Palsha area around 2:00am and arrested the two from there.

Ranju Pramanik, 38, joint secretary of Jubo League Shahjahanpur upazila unit, came under attack by a gang of 10 at a shop near America Boarding in Gohail area in the upazila on February 8. They hit him with sharp weapons, leaving him death on the spot.

Ranju's wife Jorina

Begum filed murder a case with Shahjahanpur Police Station on Feb 10, accusing eight named, including Likhon and Fuad, and six unnamed people.

Contacted, Officer-in-Charge (OC) Abdul Mannan of the police station said the arrestees were also wanted in Jubo League leader Bush Murder case.

Law enforcers are raiding different areas to arrest the rest of the accused in Ranju murder case, the OC added.

# Man takes own life after wife's suicide

A young man yesterday took his life following suicide of his wife in Parbatipur upazila of the district the day before.

Kanchan Roy, 30, son of K h o k a R o y, o f Chandinapara village, jumped off a running train at Monmathapur village in the upazila at noon and died on the spot.

The body was sent to Dinajpur Medical College Hospital for autopsy, said Mahmudul Alam, officer-in-charge of Parbatipur Police Station.

Locals said Kanchan married Lota Rani Roy, 23, of the area, six months ago.

After their marriage, Kanchan's parents often tortured Lota for dowry.

On Sunday night, Lota tried to commit suicide by hanging herself from the ceiling of her room following an altercation with her in-laws over the issue.

Kanchan rescued Lota and took her to Rangpur Medical College Hospital where she died the following night.

Shocked at the death of Lota, Kanchan took his life yesterday noon, said family sources.

# Fratricide over land dispute in Pabna

A man beat his elder brother dead over a land dispute at Bhajpara village in Pabna Sadar upazila yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Nawab Ali Pramanik, 50, of the village.

Police quoted deceased's family members as saying that there had been a long-standing dispute between two siblings, Nawab Ali and Abdul Latif, over the ownership of land.

Both the brothers engaged in an altercation over the issue around 7:00am and at one stage, Latif severely beat up Nawab

with an iron rod and fled the scene, leaving him critically injured.

Family members rushed Nawab to Pabna Medical College Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries soon after admission. On information, police went to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to the hospital morgue for autopsy.

Victim's son Atiar Hossain filed a case with Sadar Police Station accusing Latif and four others, Ahsanul Haque, officer-in-charge of the police station said.

Police are trying to nab the culprits, the OC said.

## ABSENCE IN UPAZILA HEALTH COMPLEX

# Salaries of 7 docs held up, show cause notice issued

The civil surgeon's office in Sirajganj district has ordered holding up of the monthly salary of seven doctors of Kamarkhand Upazila Health Complex and issued show cause notice for their alleged irregularities in duty.

Civil Surgeon (CS) Dr Mohammed Shamsuddin during an official visit on Monday found seven doctors the health complex -- Rifat Ara Sharmin, Nirmal Chandra Mahato, Sania Islam, Apu Shah, Shakil Shapti, Imran Hossain and Shahed Khan, absent there.

"The seven doctors did not come to the office without taking any permission from the department. We have issued an order to the district accounts office to hold up their salary for March and also served show cause notices against them to reply within 10 days," the civil surgeon told this correspondent.

"Of the accused, Nirmal Chandra and Apu Shah joined the health complex today [Tuesday] but the five others are yet to join. They did not take any leave from the office," said Shariful Islam Siddik, Kamarkhand upazila health and family plan-

ning officer. Amid allegations of frequent absence and negligence of duty by doctors in different health complexes and other medical units in Sirajganj district, the civil surgeon's office recently started drives against truant doctors.

"We have formed nine monitoring teams in the district to oversee upazila health complexes and other medical units of the district. The teams will continue drive in different health units of the district and take steps against those who fail to perform duty regularly," said the civil surgeon.

# Police beat up tea stall owner over a trivial matter

Policemen beat up a tea stall owner in front of the police officers' mess at Mahila College More in Lalmonirhat town and confined him to Sadar Police Station, following a trivial matter on Monday night, locals said.

Amid demonstration by local people, he was released after two hours.

The assaulted tea stall owner took primary treatment in the emergency department of Lalmonirhat Sadar Hospital.

A heated exchange occurred between tea stall owner Abdul Sabuj and police constable Ekramul Haque when the latter was trying to wash his legs with tube-well water inside the shop, locals said.

The matter was settled there but after sometime a few policemen rushed to the

spot, picked up the tea stall owner, took him in front of the police officer's mess at Mahila College More, and beat him mercilessly in presence of people there, locals said.

The assistant superintendent of police (ASP -- Circle) in Lalmonirhat was also present on the spot, they said.

"I did not do anything wrong, but police showed their power illegally and beat me mercilessly. I am now sick and taking treatment," said Abdul Sabuj.

Denying the allegation of torturing the tea stall owner, ASP (Circle) Adibul Islam said, "The stall owner and his son misbehaved and attacked the police constable without any proper reason. The stall owner was taken to the police station, and released later on the night."
