March 25 massacre solemnly remembered in capital

The Museum of Independence, situated beneath the Swadhinota Stombho (the glass tower) on the historical Suhrawardy Uddyan in the capital, opens today for all marking the Independence Day.

The underground museum with over 300 pictures depicting Bangladesh's history in 144 panels will remain open from 9:30am to 4:30pm today.

However, its regular timing will be 10:30am to 5:30pm from Saturday to Wednesday, and 3:00pm to 8:00pm on Friday, and it will remain closed on Thursday and government holidays, said Cultural Affairs Minister Asaduzzaman Noor at a press conference yesterday.

Tickets to the museum, Tk 10 for adults and Tk 2 for children under 12 years, are available near the eternal flame inside the Uddyan, said Faizul Latif Chowdhury, director of the National Museum.

He said the Uddyan witnessed making of

many histories including Bangabandhu's speech of March 7 calling to the nation to prepare for freedom and the surrender of the Pakistani occupation army on December 16, 1971.

After the press conference the minister inaugurated a photo exhibition on the Liberation War and Genocide 1971 on the complex premises, sprawling over 67 acres.

The cultural affairs ministry also arranged a day-long programme for today at the stage surrounding the Stombho where artistes will present patriotic songs from 7:30am to 9:00am and movies will be shown from 11:00am to 4:30pm.

Farabi on remand in an older case

Shafiur Rahman Farabi who has been detained in writer and blogger Avijit Roy killing case, was yesterday sent on a fiveday remand in another case filed last year under the Information and Communication Technology Act.

A Dhaka court passed the order after Abdur Rouf, a subinspector of Sher-e-Bangla Police Station and investigation officer of the case, produced him before it. One Mir Abdullah Harun Jewel of Agargaon filed the case

on July 23 last year alleging that Farabi posted indecent comments about different religions, including Hinduism and Buddhism, on Facebook for over two years. Earlier in the day, Farabi was produced before another Dhaka court after completion of his nine-day remand in another case filed under the ICT act on March 14 for issuing threats to kill Avijit on Facebook. Farabi was arrested on March 2 and sent on a 10day remand in the case filed on February 27 over Avijit killing.

Unknown assailants hacked to death Avijit and seriously injured his blogger wife Rafida Ahmed Bonya on the Dhaka University campus on February 26.

That day a procession the families brought out under Dighinala Bhumi Rakkha Committee's banner was intercepted by the joint forces comprising army, police and ansar personnel.

Rights activists at yesterday's human chain, which the committee organised with many of the displaced people, demanded release of the 11 indigenous persons arrested, and withdrawal of a case filed after the clash. "The government always boasts of restoring peace and bringing development to the hill districts," Dighinala upazila parishad vice-chairman Shushomoy Chakma told the gathering.

"But what is peace and development to the people who have lost their ancestral lands and homesteads?"

Barrister Sadia Arman pointed out that there would be no such frequent land disputes in Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT), had the CHT land commission been properly functioning after its formation following the 1997 CHT peace accord.

"Rapes, murders, and forced disappearances take place in the hill tracts regularly. It has been already proven that an increased presence of armed forces personnel will not solve the problems. The government should find democratic means to solve the issues in CHT," she said.

Maj Kamal Uddin of BGB 51 Battalion finds these people making false and irrational claims to make some money in the name of compensation. "A vested quarter, which does not want the headquarters

to be built here, has instigated the indigenous people," he had told The Daily Star earlier.
