# Activities at Baghabari river starts to save 50 villages port badly hampered

AHMED HUMAYUN KABIR TOPU, back from Baghabari,

The countrywide non-stop blockade enforced by BNPled 20-party alliance adds to poor functioning of Baghabari river port, already affected by decreased navigability of the Jamuna River in the ongoing dry season.

Only 38 vessels were unloaded at the river port till the first week of March this year while over 100 vessels were unloaded there during the time last year, said Md Abdus Salam, lease holder of

Baghabari port. "Most of over 2,000 workers here fail to get regular work as port activities has decreased during the last couple of weeks," said Md Monsur Ali, a port worker.

"The situation has arisen as only a poor number of vessels can come to the port due to navigability problem while the non-stop blockade and frequent hartals hamper arrival of goods carrying trucks here," said Al Mahamud, a leader of port workers' association.
