Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha yesterday urged students to study, be realistic when it comes to dreams and work with honesty, all for the welfare of mankind. The young generation should follow the spirit and ideology of Swami Vivekananda (an Indian Hindu monk of the 19th century who founded the Ramakrishna Mission) to be inspired into working for the betterment of the society without cherishing any interest and expectation, he said. The chief justice was addressing as chief guest a reunion, the first to be organised by former students of Vivekananda Bidyarthibhaban, one of Ramakrishna Mission's halls of residence, on the mission's premises in the capital. Terrorism centring religion is ongoing around the world although Swami Vivekananda pointed it out long ago that all the religions talk of service to mankind, he added.

2 die in compressor explosion

Two people were killed and two others injured as a compressor exploded at a dyeing factory in the capital's Kadamtali last night. The deceased were Delwar, 45, and Sohag, 25, while the injured are Zillur Rahman, 30, and Musa, 25. The accident occurred at Evergreen Dyeing Factory around 9:30pm. They were taken to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital where doctors declared Delwar and Sohag dead around 10:15pm. Humayun Ahmed, supervisor of the factory, said around 10 to 12 workers were working during the explosion. The four victims were closer to the compressor, he added.

Family members allege that men showing IDs of detectives picked up the joint secretary general from a house in the capital's Uttara on the night of March 10. Asked by the High Court following a petition by his wife, five law enforcement agencies submitted reports to the attorney general's office on March 15 saying they did not arrest him. Replying to journalists' queries after attending as chief guest a convention of Tangail's community police on the zila parishad premises, the IGP said, "If we had arrested him, we would have produced him before a court...we are trying all out to rescue him." He said Salahuddin's family, apart from police, had responsibilities, in this case informing law enforcers in writing of him going "missing". Salahuddin's wife earlier said she had gone to the Uttara (West) Police Station the day after the abduction but police refused accepting her general diary.
