## Teacher canes 42 students

Locals, guardians knock out headmaster's teeth

Locals and guardians knocked out two front teeth of the headmaster after another teacher caned 42 students in a school at Bagha upazila yesterday.

The class VIII students of Chandipur High School were caned in their classroom around 10:00am after they refused to pay money for a picnic, said police and witnesses.

There were marks of canning on their backs. Assaulted, Headmaster Nazrul Islam was admitted to

Bagha Health Complex, said Upazila Nirbahi Officer Badal Chandra Haldar. Assistant Teacher Mohammad Ali, who "tortured" the students, was forced to submit his resignation to the school

authorities, he added. The picnic was supposed to be held tomorrow and the school had fixed Tk 100 as fee for every student. The spot

was yet to be decided, added police and witnesses. When the students were being beaten up, one of them,

## Uproot terrorism

PM tells law-enforcers; hails Rab at its 11th anniversary

UNB, Dhaka

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday directed the law enforcement agencies, including Rapid Action Battalion (Rab), to work with utmost sincerity to eliminate terrorism.

She also stressed talking to neighbouring countries to check passport and currency forgery as international groups were involved in the criminal acts.

Hasina was addressing a Darbar of the elite force at its headquarters in Kurmitola in the capital marking its 11th founding anniversary.

About BNP-Jamaat clique's subversive activities in the name of political programmes, Hasina reiterated that the government would not tolerate killing people with petrol bombs and arson attacks. "We'll have to provide security to the people."

She also directed the members of Rab, drawn from various forces, to perform their duties maintaining the chain of command as well as the law, rules and policy of the elite force.

# 'People will know my name'

Former girlfriend of tormented co-pilot says health issues might have led him to suicide

The co-pilot who crashed a passenger jet into the French Alps, killing all 150 aboard, worried "health problems" would dash his dreams and vowed one day to do something to "change the whole system", an ex-girlfriend told a

German newspaper. The woman, a flight stewardess named only as Maria W, said Andreas Lubitz told her he was receiving psychiatric treatment and

would wake up distressed in the night during their fivemonth relationship in 2014. "At night, he woke up and screamed: 'We're going down!', because he had nightmares," she said. "He knew how to hide from other people what was really going on inside."

She was quoted by the German newspaper Bild as recall ing how Lubitz would change when he talked about the pressures and conditions of his job.

"He never talked much about his illness, only that he was

in psychiatric treatment," she said. "We always talked a lot about work and then he became a


# Transformers by father, son
