# 4 absconding pro-Jamaat teachers still get salary

## DEO serves show cause notice to the madrasa governing body chiefs for violating order

Four absconding madrasa teachers, also local leaders of Jamaat-e-Islami, have been receiving monthly salary bills signed by presidents of the institutions' governing bodies loyal to the ruling Awami League despite an order issued by the district education officer (DEO) to hold up their salary.

They are Vice Principal of Palashbari Senior Fazil Madrasa Abdul Majid Akanda, ameer of Palashbari upazila unit of Jamaat, head of the institution's primary section Mozammel Huq, a member of the unit, principal of Merrihat Senior Fazil Madrasa AKM Nazrul Islam, organising secretary of the district unit of Jamaat, Assistant Professor of the madrasa Beluddin Sarkar, a member of the district unit of the party.

On February 2, DEO Kutubuddin issued an order to hold up the salary of the four people as they were absconding accused in several cases including those for terrorism and violence. But member of the upazila unit of AL Jahangir Alam, also president of Palashbari Senior Fazil Madrasa's governing body, and organising secretary of the unit Shahidul Islam, also president of Merrihat Senior Fazil Madrasa's governing body, signed the salary bills of the accused, violating the order, said the DEO.

The four received salary bills for the month of February, said Sadrul Amin, manager of Palashbari

Sonali Bank branch.

Contacted, Shahidul Islam, president of Merrihat Senior Fazil Madrasa's governing body, said "I signed the salary bills for verifying the papers and attendance register of teachers but I am not aware about the order issued by the education officer."

"I served show cause notices to the presidents of the institutions' governing bodies in this regard," said the DEO.

The four Jamaat men accused in several cases including for terrorism and violence were absconding for long, said Mojobur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Palashbari Police Station.

Police are raiding different areas to arrest the accused, said the OC.

# Murder accused held

Police yesterday arrested the prime accused in a case for abducting and killing a six-year-old schoolboy in Chhatak upazila of Sunamganj district.

The arrestee is Suyabur Rahman, 32, of Bramonjulia village in the upazila, said Ashraf Islam, sub-inspector of Dakkhin Surma Police Station in Sylhet district.

On secret information, a police team raided a restaurant in Sylhet Central Bus Terminal area at 8:45am and arrested Suyabur.

During primary interrogation, Suyabur confessed to abducting and murdering

Emon, son of Johur Ali of Batirkandi village in Chhatak upazila, said the SI.

On March 28, a gang picked up Emon, a student of class one of Lafarge Primary School in Chhatak upazila, from in front of his house and took him to an unknown place.

The abductors then demanded Tk two lakh as ransom from the family for his release over mobile phone, said Harun-ur-Rashid, officer-in-charge of the police station.

Emon's body was recovered from a pond under Dakkhin Surma upazila in Sylhet on March 31, said police.

A case was filed in this connection, said the OC.

# Ulfa leader, local aide get life term

A court here yesterday sentenced United Liberation Front of Asom (Ulfa) leader Ranjan Chowdhury and his Bangladeshi aide Pradip Marak to life term imprisonment in two cases for arms and terrorism.

District and Sessions Judge Mahbub Ul Islam pronounced the verdict in presence of the convicts. The court also fined the lifers Tk

20,000 each.

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab-9) had arrested Ranjan Chowdhury alias Major Ranjan, 46, former general secretary of Dhobra district unit of Ulfa, and his Bangladeshi aide Pradip Marak, 57, of Bakura village in Jhinaigati upazila of Sherpur district, from Bhrarai upazila in Kishoreganj district on July 17, 2010.

The elite force also recovered two pistols, four bullets, four handmade bombs and some bomb making materials from Ranjan's hideout at Laxmipur village in Bhairab upazila.

Rab filed four separate cases, including those for intrusion, terrorism, and keeping arms and explosives, against the duo with the Bhairab Police Station.

# 7 cops hurt in clash with villagers, nine held

At least seven policemen were injured in an attack by a group of local people from a waz mahfil (Islamic sermon) at Tiloki village in Bholahat upazila early yesterday.

Police said a group of local people arranged a waz mahfil at an orchard on Monday night.

Being informed that the

speakers at the mahfil are delivering offensive speeches against the prime minister and over the current political situation, a police team rushed to the spot around 12:30am, said Abdur Razzak, officer-in-charge of Bholahat Police Station.

Sensing the presence of the police, a group of locals started pelting bricks towards the law enforcers, leaving seven policemen injured.

Injured Sub-inspectors Abdul Mazid and Shishir Kumar, Assistant Sub-inspector Shukur Ali, and four Constables-Shafiqul Islam, Aminul Islam, Abul Kalam and Abdul Aziz were given primary treatment at Bholahat Upazila Health Complex.

Police fired five rounds of blank shots to bring the situation under control and later detained nine people from the spot.

# Man arrested on rape charge

Police early yesterday arrested a man on charge of raping a mentally challenged girl at Mobuakhal village in Dhunat upazila of the district on March 13.

The arrestee is Nayeb Ali, 35, son of late Jalal Uddin of the village.

The law enforcers arrested him from his house around 1:30am after victim's elder sister Fatema Khatun filed a rape case with Dhunat Police Station on Tuesday afternoon.

Police quoted victim's family members as saying that Nayeb violated the 25-year-old mentally challenged girl at her house in absence of her family members on March 13 and fled the scene.

Hearing her groaning, locals went to the spot, rescued her and took her to a local doctor for treatment.

Police produced the arrestee before a court yesterday afternoon that sent him to the jail, said Ziaur Rahman, officer-in-charge of the police station.

# Lone teacher for 5 classes!

Academic activities at Purbo Narayan Government Primary School in Palashbari upazila of the district are being seriously hampered due to shortage of teachers.

School sources said three posts, including that of the headmaster have been lying vacant for long, much to the sufferings of over 100 students of the institution.

The student of the school have been deprived from

proper education as Sumi Akhter, the lone assistant teacher, also acting headmaster of the school, could not cope with her duties and gets only a little opportunity to conduct classes.

Many guardians said their children spent most of their time either by playing or gossiping during the school hours. As a result, a number of students left the school this year due to lack of proper education.

The headmaster of the school was transferred to

another place on May 28 in 2014 and an assistant teacher a few months later.

Of the remaining two, another assistant teacher went on leave for attending a training course the same year.

Sumi Akhter said despite informing the authorities concerned the situation still remains the same.

Contacted, Amirul Islam, district primary education officer, said, "We have already deputed a teacher recently and the remaining two will be replaced soon."
