172 aspirants face cases

34 accused of murder, says Shujan report on DNCC, DSCC candidates' records

A total of 172 mayor and councillor aspirants in two Dhaka city corporations are facing lawsuits, including 34 for murder.

Among the 464 councillor hopefuls in Dhaka South City Corporation (DNCC), 96 are accused in cases.

In Dhaka South City Corporation (DSCC), 72 councillor candidates out of the total of 356 are facing cases, said a report by Shushashoner Janney Nagorik (Shujan).

The civil society organisation published the report through

a press conference at Dhaka Reporters Unity yesterday.
Only one out of the 16 mayor hopefuls in North is facing a murder charge. In South, three mayor aspirants out of 20

are accused in cases, according to the report.

It found that around 67.20 and 71.28 percent contestants in DNCC and DSCC are businessmen. Nine mayor hopefuls in DNCC are from the business community while the DSCC has 14 businessmen running for mayor.

EDUCATION
In DNCC, 59.40 percent mayor and councillor aspirants are educated up to Secondary School Certificate (SSC) level or less, while the figure is 66.73 percent in DSCC.



The visitors will start their campaign with a oneday warm-up game against a BCB XI tomorrow at the Fatullah Cricket Stadium.





7 ex-officials of Oriental Bank jailed

A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced seven former officials of defunct Oriental Bank to 10 years' rigorous imprisonment each for embezzling Tk 1 crore in the name of disbursement. The seven officials of the bank, presently known as ICB

Islamic Bank Ltd, were also fined Tk 1.90 crore.

The court asked the authorities concerned to realise the fine from the convicts after their surrender or arrest and

deposit the money to the state treasury.

Judge Hosne Ara Begum of the Special Judge Court-3 pronounced the verdict in their absentia. The punishment of the fugitives will become effective from the day of their arrest or surrender.
