Missing schoolboys found dead in Jessore, Faridpur

Two schoolboys, who went missing from Jessore and Faridpur districts on April 11 and April 14, were found dead yesterday and on Wednesday night.

Our Benapole correspondent reported that Abhaynagar police in Jessore recovered the body of an 11-year-old schoolboy from Teka River on Wednesday evening.

The deceased, Sajedur Rahman Shahed, son of Saiful Islam of Panchakari

village in Monirampur upazila, was a Class V student at Nehalpur Pre-Cadet School.

Quoting victim's family members, Sheikh Nasir Uddin, officer-in-charge of Abhaynagar Police Station, said Shahed went out of his house on April 11 and remained missing since then.

Victim's uncle Rabiul Islam later lodged a general diary (GD) with Monirampur Police Station.

Locals spotted Shahed's body floating on the river on

Wednesday evening and informed the police. Being informed, police recovered the body and sent it to Jessore Medical College Hospital for autopsy, the OC added.

Away in Faridpur, a schoolboy, who remained missing since April 14, was found dead at Pashra village in Sadar upazila yesterday morning.

The deceased is Azam, 14, a Class VIII student at Pashra MN Aziz High School.

Locals found Azam's

body floating in a pond adjacent to his school in the morning and informed the police, said Sayed Mohsinul Haque, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station.

On information, police recovered the body and sent it to the hospital morgue for autopsy.

Azam's father Sheikh Farid said his son went out of his house to attend a function, marking the Pahela Baishakh on Tuesday and did not return.

29 fishermen abducted in Bay

Armed robbers kidnapped 29 fishermen along with their fishing trawler from Sonadia Channel of the Bay of Bengal in Moheshkhali upazila early yesterday.

Joynal Abedin, owner of the trawler, said 31 fishermen from Kutubdia upazila went to the Bay aboard the trawler for netting fish on Sunday.

A gang of 12/15 armed robbers swooped on them while they were fishing near Sonadia Channel around 3:00am and took the fishermen hostage at gunpoint.

10 hurt, houses, shops vandalised as rival AL men clash in Pabna

At least 10 people were injured and five houses and 10 shops were vandalised during a clash between two rival groups of Awami League in Natiabari area under Bera upazila of the district yesterday.

Officer-in-Charge Md Jasim Uddin of Aminpur Police Station said there had been a long-standing feud between Fazlur Rahman, president of Jatshakini union unit of AL, and Abu Bakkar, a member of the unit, over

establishing supremacy in the area.

As a sequel to the conflict, the supporters of the two locked in a clash near the residence of AL lawmaker Azizul Haque Arzu at around 9:00am.

They hurled brick chips at each other and used lethal weapons during the clash, leaving at least 10 people from both sides injured.

At least 10 shops and five houses were vandalised in the area during the clash that continued for half an hour.

Being informed, police rushed to the spot and fired blank shots to disperse the clashing groups. The law enforcers also arrested 13 people from there.

A tense situation was prevailing in the area as of filing of this report at 5:00pm. Police have been deployed in the area to avert any further incident.

Contacted, Lawmaker Azizul Haque Arzu said attempts are being made to resolve the conflict between Fazlu and Bakkar.
