


I am delighted to know that Bangladesh University of Business and Technology (BUBT) is holding its 2nd Convocation on April 21, 2015.



A Brief Profile

The University

Bangladesh University of Business and Technology (BUBT) was established under the Private University Act in the year 2003 modelled on North American Universities, with the approval of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the Ministry of Education, Government of Bangladesh. It was founded by Dhaka Commerce College, Mirpur-2, Dhaka, and is managed by a Board of Trustees and a Syndicate. BUBT is one of the leading universities in the private sector of Bangladesh. It has been providing quality education, training and research facility to its students since its very inception. At present BUBT has established itself as a top ranking Private University in the country, not only by fulfilling all the requirements of the Private University Act, 2010, but also by maintaining the standard of education, research facilities, transparent admission and examination system, quality students, updated academic programs, up to date curricula, necessary physical infrastructures, co-curricular and extracurricular activities, modern facilities for the students and a disciplined environment.

Mission

The mission of Bangladesh University of Business and Technology (BUBT) is to provide students with high quality education and training that are relevant to the needs of the modern society at affordable costs. BUBT is committed to academic excellence at all costs to help students achieve their career goals within a supportive atmosphere.

Objectives

The principal objective of Bangladesh University of Business and Technology (BUBT) is to produce highly skilled manpower capable of contributing to the national development as entrepreneurs, academics, professionals and administrators.

Location of University

The permanent campus of BUBT is located at Rupnagar, Mirpur-2, Dhaka-1216 with two spacious nine storied buildings with all facilities for higher education. The second campus of BUBT is located adjacent to Dhaka Commerce College, Mirpur-2, Dhaka-1216. It is surrounded by a good number of educational institutions in an excellent academic atmosphere. The campuses of BUBT have excellent communication links from all parts of Dhaka City as well as from outside the City by buses, taxies, rickshaws

Accreditation

The University has been approved by the Ministry of Education, Government of Bangladesh, on the recommendation of the University Grants Commission. BUBT has the credit transfer facility and academic collaboration with British, American and Australian Universities. BUBT is a member of the Association of Commonwealth Universities and the International Association of Universities.

Commitments

In BUBT we believe that higher education should not be concentrated only on providing with and acquiring of theoretical knowledge form the books through traditional class room lectures. We give equal emphasis on other methods of teaching and learning. We frequently organize seminars, symposiums, debates, discussion meetings, presentation sessions, contests, competitions etc. for the students at intra-university, inter-university, national and international levels. Through the time-based and need based education, training and research by using the various modern methods and techniques we help the students to be transformed into human resources, rather than unemployed educated youths and be burdens for themselves, for their families and for the country as a whole.

To materialize the dream of digital Bangladesh into reality, BUBT has been giving special emphasis on science and engineering education since its inception. We develop our students focusing on Computer Science, IT, ICT and other related areas so that they can meet the challenges of the modern

We believe that search for the unknown is very important for generating new knowledge, new ideas, new thoughts and new information that can enhance the quality of education. In BUBT there is a full fledged Research Department headed by a highly qualified and experienced Professor for providing training on Research Methodology and other relevant areas both to the faculty members and students and also for conducting research projects on various socio-economic issues of the country.

To give our students international exposure in the academic arena, BUBT has already established academic collaborations and exchange programs with a number of American, British and Australian Universities and a few more are in progress. Both students and faculty members are taking advantage of these collaborations in the form of credit transfer, joint research, library access and cross fertilization of knowledge.

Career Development office of BUBT has been reorganized for providing individual counseling and other advisory services to the students for their career planning and professional skill development and for placement of the students as internees with different organizations.

Through academic programs, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities we help and guide our students acquire an extent of knowledge, a breadth of mind and soundness of character that may enable them to be familiar with the whole of their environment, so that they can face the hard realities of life with courage, they can face the competitions of employment market with confidence and also can face the challenges of the 21st century with a greater determination and success.

BUBT has generous scholarship, stipend and tuition fee waiver programs to support the meritorious, poor, disadvantaged students, wards of Freedom Fighters and also students of remote underdeveloped regions of the country.

BUBT is committed to academic excellence and it follows a model of higher education consisting of trimesters, courses, credit hours, continuous evaluation and letter grading, conforming to general international standards. The academic year begins from October and runs through September of the following year. An academic year is divided into following three trimesters:

Fall: October-January Spring: February-May Summer: June- September

The trimester duration is usually of fifteen weeks (thirteen weeks for classes and two weeks for final examination and result.)

Financial Assistance

There are provisions for scholarships, stipends and tuition fee waiver for the students in BUBT.

1. Scholarships, stipends and fee waivers are awarded to students on the

basis of need and merit. 2.100 percent fee waiver is awarded to sons and daughters of Freedom

3. For Undergraduate Programs special tuition fee waiver from 25% to 100% based on total GPA of the SSC and the HSC Examination results is

given for the first trimester. 4. For subsequent trimester tuition fee waiver is also awarded on the basis of examination results of each trimester in BUBT.

5. Students of Dhaka Commerce College are allowed an additional 10 percent tuition fee waiver.

Tuition fee waiver is awarded for sibling and spouse. **Faculty Members**

BUBT has an effective team of 275 well-qualified full time faculty

members for taking intensive care of each and every student and guiding them in and outside the classroom. Moreover, a good number of foreign qualified and experienced faculty members of Dhaka University, Jahangirnagar University and Institute of Business Administration (IBA) and other professional organizations teach at BUBT as adjunct faculty. Seminar and Symposium

The University, through its faculties and departments, organizes, from time to time, seminars and symposiums on national and global issues, concerning trade, commerce and industry, different topics on English Literature and Language and recent development in Economics and other Social Sciences, Computer Science and Mathematics. Distinguished personalities of different universities and professional organizations both at home and abroad present papers and participate in discussion, along with the faculty members and students of BUBT.


