Top criminal Emon jailed for 17 years for illegal arms

possession

COURT CORRESPONDENT

A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced Sanjidul Hassan Emon, one of the 23 top listed criminals, to 17 years' rigorous imprisonment in a case filed in 2008 for possessing illegal arms and ammunition.

This is the first time that a court handed down a sentence to Emon, an accused in a dozen of cases including the film actor Sohel Chowdhury murder case. The BNP-led four-party

December 27, 2001 announced a list of 23 most wanted criminals, Emon was one of them. Following the declaration, Emon went into hiding in India. But Indian

BCL leader bashes fellow's head in for misbehaviour

Rajshahi University unit suspends victim, recommends the same for attacker to central committee

Delwar Hossain alias Dels, vice president of Bangladesh Chhatra League at Rajshahi University and general secretary of · BCL's Madar Bux Hall unit, yesterday bashed a junior leader on the head, accusing the latter of misbehaving with him.

Dels admitted that he beat up Hazrat Ali, organising secretary of the hall unit BCL. Ali allegedly threatened the . dining hall manager when asked for a due bill of Tk 100. On information, when Dels inquired about it, Ali misbehaved with him, alleged Dels. Later, RU BCL President Mizanur Rahman and Acting General Secretary Khaled Hasan Biplob sat down with the two in the hall where at one stage of an . altercation, Dels struck Ali in the head with a lock.

Ali who had two stitches for his wounds at Rajshahi University Medical Centre denied the allegation of misbehaviour.

The RU unit of BCL suspended Ali from the hall committee and recommended that the central BCL committee suspend Dels. Proctor Prof Tarikul Hasan said they would: take stern action after an investigation.

AL MEN'S BULLYING AT RU VC'S OFFICE

Ruta chief now protests media reports about him

Calls the conduct 'discourteous behaviour' a day after terming it just an altercation; continues drawing criticisms from colleagues; sociology dept to go on 2-day class boycott from today as protests keep intensifying

Protesting media reports on his comments, Rajshahi University Teachers Association (Ruta) President Prof Ananda Kumar Saha yesterday termed Awami League leader Dablu Sarker's virulent behaviour at the vice-chancellor's office "discourteous", a day after he had called it a "simple altercation" and the news reports about the incident "false and fabricated", at a human chain.

Meanwhile, several hundred teachers and students continued agitation on the campus for the fifth day yesterday, demanding punishment for Awami League lawmaker Omar Faruque Chowdhury and the ; party's city unit General Secretary Dablu Sarker for misbehaving with the RU VC and its teachers on April 15 and 16.

RU's sociology department will boycott classes today and tomorrow, protesting the incidents. VC Dr Muhammad Mizanuddin

is a professor of the department. Ruta President Ananda Kumar issued his personal statement on Ruta's official letterhead protesting the media reports. He claimed that online newspapers' reports on manhandling the VC were not correct. Prof Ananda said the behaviour of the AL leader with the VC and other teachers was discourteous and he stated this repeatedly and in

the banner of Ruta. Around 50 journalists, including The Daily Star's university correspondent, who were covering Monday's human chain, had instantly protested the remarks of Prof

Ananda who termed the media reports "false and fabricated." Most teachers at the human chain also

protested his comment and demanded immediate withdrawal of it. Many teachers also called Prof Ananda a "lackey". Earlier, several teachers told The Daily

Star that they suspected that Prof Ananda had been conspiring with the AL men and trying to gain blessings from the ruling party to be appointed VC of the university. He denied the allegation.

Some senior teachers, seeking anonymity, yesterday told The Daily Star that Prof Ananda should resign from his post for such "irresponsible" behaviour.

However, the Ruta president joined a protest rally of Rajshahi University Kendrio Sangskritik Jote against the virulent behaviour of the AL lawmaker and the leader.

More than 1,000 teachers, students and staff formed a human chain before the senate building around 11:00am, demanding punitive action against the AL MP and the party leaders who threatened the VC and manhandled some teachers at the VC's office. They also demanded exemplary punish-

ment for the culprits who molested some 20 females on Dhaka University campus on Pahela Baishakh.

Over 300 teachers and students of sociology joined another human chain in front of Mamtaj Uddin Arts Building, demanding immediate arrest of the ruling party leaders.

They also declared the duo persona non grata on the campus.

HC summons govt secy for explaining delay in relocating Dhaka tanneries

The High Court yesterday summoned the industries secretary to appear before it on May 19 for not relocating the tanneries of the capital's Hazaribagh by February 28, 2010 in line with its directive of June 23, 2009.

On October 30, 2010, the HC gave them six months more to relocate those.

The industries ministry took a project to move the tanneries to Savar in 2003. And 155 industrial plots were also allocated there for this purpose.

Customs seizes 70 noncompliant motorbikes in capital STAFF CORRESPONDENT

Customs Intelligence and Investigation Department seized 70 illegal motorbikes worth Tk 7 crore from Kamalapur Inland Container Depot in Dhaka yesterday. Customs officials said the engine capacities of the

motorbikes are more than 800cc which is beyond the legal limit. On March16 last year, the customs authorities halted

the unloading of a consignment of the motorbikes imported by Balaka Enterprise of Free School Street. Following a High Court order on March 23 this year

after a law battle, the customs authorities examined the motorbikes yesterday and made the seizure.

2 govt officials summoned by HC for not yet handing over SC land to it

The High Court yesterday summoned the women and children affairs secretary and the Shishu Academy director to appear before it on May 6 for not handing over to the Supreme Court a piece of land that belongs to it, despite an order.

SC lawyer Manzill Murshid, who moved the petition, said the HC in March 2011 directed the authorities concerned to protect and maintain the 55.5 acres of land, and, later, the Appellate Division upheld the HC order. Shishu Academy has been occupying the four acres of the SC land, he said.
