

SYMPTOMS OF CERVICAL CANCER

- Bleeding from the vagina that is not normal, such as bleeding between menstrual periods, after
- sex, or after menopause. Pain in the lower belly or pelvis.
- Pain during sex.
- Vaginal discharge that isn't normal.

THE TREATMENT FOR **MOST STAGES OF** CERVICAL CANCER

- Surgery, such as a hysterectomy and removal of pelvic lymph nodes with or without removal of both ovaries and fallopian tubes. Chemotherapy.
- Radiation therapy.

A Pap test can find changes in cervical cells before they turn into cancer If you treat these cell changes, you may prevent cervical cancer.

Vaccinations are now available for cervical cancer. Dr Nasima Akhter

MBBS, PHD (Japan), MS (GYNAE & OBS), Assistant Prof. & Head of Department, Gynaecology of Ibn Sina Hospital and Diagnostic Center says, "The hospitals get the vaccine from Glaxosmithkline, the only company that currently sells vaccines for cervical cancer." The procedure to apply the vaccination is to first keep it contained in a cool temperature and is an Intramuscular injection. "While early sexual intercourse, multiple sexual partners, early childbirth and smoking are the most talked about causes for the disease, another one that applies in our country is poor socio-economic conditions. The poor hygiene can lead to a woman having cervical cancer," says Dr. Nasima.
