### Two housewives murdered

Two housewives were murdered in Sirajganj and Naogaon districts yesterday and the day before.

In Sirajganj, a woman was killed allegedly by her husband for dowry at Amdanga village in Salanga upazila on Wednesday afternoon, reports UNB.

The deceased was identified as Sima Khatun, 22, wife of Jahangir Alam, son of Abdul Gani of the village.

Sub-Inspector Mofijul Islam of Salanga Police Station said Seema, daughter of Pana Ullah Pramanik of Bagdha village, married Jahangir last year.

After their marriage, Jahangir and his family members often tortured Seema for dowry.

On the fateful day, Jahangir and his family members strangled Seema following an altercation over the issue.

Being informed, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Sirajganj Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

A case was filed against five people, including Jahangir, in this connection. The accused went into

#### BGB sues 150 villagers

Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) on Wednesday night sued 150 people of Lalitarhat village in Patgram upazila on charge of attacking a BGB patrol team near Lalitarhat border on Tuesday night.

Havilder Ataur Rahman, Kuchlibari camp commander of BGB 15 Battalion, filed the case with Patgram Police Station,

accusing Jahedul Islam and 149 unnamed people, said Rezaul Karim, officer-incharge of the police station.

According to the case statement, a gang attacked a BGB patrol team and tried to snatch their firearms soon after the law enforces detained Jahedul along with smuggled Indian tobacco.


