

# ROW OVER MOVE TO NEW BUILDING IN JU Hunger strike of two depts continues

Fifteen students and two teachers of computer science and engineering (CSE) and geological sciences departments of Jahangirnagar University continued observing a fast-unto-death programme protesting a decision of the authorities to move the environmental sciences department into their building.

Claiming the building is not big enough for all three departments, they began their protest on Saturday after the syndicate last Thursday decided on the transfer.

Meanwhile, a meeting among all three departments and the university authorities yesterday could not reach a decision regarding the crisis. Another meeting is scheduled for today.

# Cop accused of torturing underage wife sent to jail

A Barisal court yesterday sent a police official to jail rejecting his bail prayer in a case filed for torturing his underage wife for dowry.

Sub-inspector Abdul Wares, 40, of Kawnia Police Station, married 14-year-old Habiba Akter Marufa, hiding information about his first marriage, and physically tortured her for dowry, said the case filed by Marufa's mother.

Marufa had to get admitted to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital from June 12 to 16 last year after being tortured by Wares, said the mother.

Wares used to lock Marufa in the house,

with no food inside, before leaving for office every day, she added.

Mahmuda filed the case on March 10, five days after police rescued her daughter from Wares' locked house with the help of Bangladesh Women Lawyers' Association.

According to Barisal police, Wares went "missing" after being suspended. On April 6, he secured a four-week bail from the HC.

Yesterday when Wares appeared before the tribunal seeking permanent bail, the court sent him to jail.

Selim Reza, officer-in-charge of the police station and also the investigation officer, submitted the charge sheet against Wares on April 28.

# North Bengal Sugar Mill to commemorate martyrs today

North Bengal Sugar (NBS) Mill will observe Shaheed Day today in

memory of the killing of its 150 officials and employees by the Pakistani army during the Liberation War.

On May 5 in 1971, Anwarul Azim, then administrator of NBS, with 150 mill staff, was killed for their participation in the war.

Their bodies were dumped into a pond on the mill premises at Gopalpur in Natore, says a press release.

On Azim's direct command, his fellow freedom fighters defeated Pakistani troops at Gopalpur rail station and blew up the Ishwardi airport. On the occasion, a Qurankhwani, a milad mahfil and a discussion will be held, which members of the martyred family will attend.

# SC sends transport businessman to jail for contempt of court

The Supreme Court yesterday sent transport businessman Abdus Shahid to jail for violating its order against constructing a building on a piece of land in Habiganj municipality.

The SC also sentenced Shahid, who owns Bismillah Paribahan, to half-a-month's simple imprisonment on charge of contempt of court. The court further ordered the municipality authorities to remove the illegal structure within a month.

Shahid, who appeared before the SC yesterday in connection with a contempt of court petition, was handed over to police.

The businessman committed contempt of court by continuing construction of the building and preventing municipality authorities from demolishing it despite an order of the SC that directed him to stop the construction, petitioner's counsel Subrata Chowdhury told The Daily Star.

He said Shahid constructed a three-storey building occupying a land of one Shyamal Kanti Das on Ramakrishna Mission Road in December 2011 without any approval from the municipality authorities.

Following a petition filed by Shyamal, joint district judge of Habiganj ordered Shahid to stop construction of the building in January 2012. Shahid later filed an appeal with the High Court challenging the Habiganj district judge's order.

On April 2012, the HC stayed the Habiganj court order. Later, Shyamal appealed to the SC against the HC order.

SC on January 27, 2013 issued a status quo on construction of the structure. But Shahid continued construction of the structure ignoring the SC status quo order.

Shyamal then filed the contempt of court petition with the SC.

On April 6 last year, the SC ordered the municipality authorities to demolish the building. Shahid, however, prevented the municipality authorities from demolishing the structure.

# Cabinet okays draft of deal on

## ROOPPUR PLANT

The draft of the "Nuclear Power Plant Bill 2015", subject to a review by the law ministry, is aimed at constructing the country's first nuclear power plant, at Rooppur in Pabna.

The cabinet also gave nod to a proposal about the creation of the "Nuclear Power Company of Bangladesh", which will be the operating agency of the plant.

The Rooppur project, involving Tk 5,087.81 crore with a project aid of Tk 4,000 crore from Russia's government, would get technical support from Russia. With an initial capacity of generating 1,000MW, the facility is expected to go into operation by 2021.

Talking about the bill, the cabinet secretary said it was an international practice to

have a firm legal framework to implement such high-tech, complicated, and capital-intensive projects.

The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) will monitor the project to ensure security and safety of the power plant, he said.

Earlier, Bangladesh signed two agreements with Russia -- for cooperation and for loan.

The proposal for creating the nuclear power company was drafted following the guidelines of the IAEA and in consultation with local and international experts. It was proposed that the implementing country has to have two organisations -- owner and operator. In the case of Rooppur plant, Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission would act as owner organisation and "Nuclear Power Company of Bangladesh" as operating agency.

instigators, many supporters who worked as "foot soldiers" were still unknown.

Hefajat claimed that 200 of its leaders and activists were killed when law enforcers flushed the protesters out of the place, but the government put the toll at 13. Hefajat could not provide names and addresses in support of its claim.

Some accused including Hefajat General Secretary Junaid Babunagari and Harun bin Izhar Chowdhury, son of Hefajat's Nayeb-e-Ameer Mufaij Izharul Islam, were arrested but they were released later on bail.

Babunagari gave a confessional statement disclosing the involvement of the activists of Hefajat, Jamaat, BNP and its front organisations in the anarchy.

Some BNP leaders, including Moudud Ahmed and Sadeque Hossain Khoka, were also shown arrested in the cases but most of them got bail later.
