Bangladeshi students receive scholarships from SMU

Two students from Dhaka, Bangladesh were recently awarded one of the highest scholarships given out to international students by a Canadian University. The CUAC is a Canadian organisation with offices worldwide to help and assist students choosing higher education in Canada. The Bangladesh office of CUAC is located in Gulshan, Dhaka and has been successfully helping Bangladeshi students for more than 18 years.
