## CHEST DISEASE CLINIC IN MYMENSINGH TOWN Patients suffer as lone X-ray machine lies inoperative

The lone X-ray machine at Chest Disease Clinic in Mymensingh town has remained inoperative for more than 16 years.

A team of the Health Directorate from Dhaka had visited the clinic five years ago and said the X-ray machine was 'non-functional.'

Another team of the directorate declared the machine 'unusable' when it visited the centre two months ago. But no step has been taken to install a new one as yet, sources said.

The clinic is a referral centre for 'External Quality

Assessment' to ensure quality test of 41 peripheral laboratories for TB treatment in Mymensingh, Sherpur, Gazipur and Manikganj.

X-ray examination is essential for treatment of TB patients. Because of the idle machine, the patients coming here have to get their tests done from private diagnostic centres, which is a burden for poor patients, said patients' relatives.

Each patient has to spend Tk 1,000 to Tk 1,200 for blood tests and X-ray, said rickshaw puller Fazlu Miah, also a TB patient.

As blood tests have to be done to detect TB, all related tests should be arranged at

the clinic, demanded TB patients Lal Miah, Anwara Begum and Sharif Miah.

Dr Mir Anwar Hossain, junior consultant (in-charge) of the clinic, said it is beyond imagination that the centre is running without X-ray machine and arrangements for TB-related tests.

Patients also face other problems in the centre. Rain water leaks through the roof in nine rooms, and the only bathroom for patients is not in use, said sources.

Babul Chandra Das, pharmacist of the clinic, said it is difficult to store the medicines due to dilapidated condition of the building.

## Boy abducted from Dhaka rescued in Dinajpur

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) rescued a six-year-old boy of Dhaka city from Birampur upazila in the district on Wednesday, five days after his abduction.

The victim is Md Shahidul Islam, son of Iqbal Quader of Korail in the capital, said a Rab official.

According to a case filed with Ramna Police Station, the boy was abducted allegedly by one Shaifiquil, who was known to Iqbal Quader.

Shaifiquil then took Shahidul to a house at Ketrhat village in Birampur and demanded Tk 5 lakh ransom from the family for his release.

At around 8:30pm on Wednesday, the elite force

with the help of local UP chairman raided the house of Shaifiquil, son of late Md Moslem Uddin of the village, and rescued the boy, said Major Abdul Mahmud Al Razi, commanding officer of Rab-13.

However, Shaifiquil along with his family members managed to flee, sensing the presence of the Rab men, said the officer.

### Man dies falling from tree

An elderly man died after falling from a tree at Ewazpur village in Charfashion upazila of the district yesterday morning. The deceased was identified as Abul Didar, 65, son of late Ismail Didar of the village. Police and locals said Abul fell to the ground while plucking mangoes from the tree near his house at around 8:00am. Critically injured Abul was rushed to the upazila health complex where the on-duty doctor declared him dead.

### Youth beaten to death

A young man was beaten to death by a mob in Mirzarpur area under Hathazari upazila on Wednesday afternoon. The deceased is Nazrul Islam alias Nazu, 35, son of late Bhola Miah of the area. Mohammad Ismail, officer-in-charge of Hathazari Police Station, said Nazu was accused in four cases, including one for robbery. When he went to the area at around 2:30pm, angry locals caught Nazu, suspecting him a robber and gave him a good beating. Nazu died on the spot, said the OC. The body was sent to Chittagong Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy. A case was filed in this connection.

### Lightning kills two

Two people were killed by lightning in Sunamganj district yesterday. The deceased are Lutfar Miah, 45, of Laxmipur village in Jamalganj upazila, and Sayed Miah, 30, of Shimulbak village in Dakkhin Sunamganj upazila. Witnesses said a thunderbolt struck Lutfar while he was going outside to bring his cattle during a heavy rain. He died on the spot. Police said Sayed was killed by lightning while he was working in his crop field at around 8:00am.

### Three arms peddlers held

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested three alleged arms traders with two shutter guns and 122 bullets in Khajra union of Ashashuni upazila of Satkhira district early yesterday. The arrestees are Majful Islam, son of Abdus Sattar Sana of Gajna village in Kolaroa upazila, Abdul Mahit Molla, son of late Abul Kashem of Rasulpur village in Sadar upazila, and Sayeed Hossain Sana, son of Mohammad Hossain Sana of Kalyanpur village in Ashashuni upazila of Satkhira district. The elite force, acting on a tip-off, raided the area and arrested the three with the arms and bullets, said Rab-6 sources.

### Two kids drown

Two minor boys drowned in a pond at Harong village in Chandina upazila under the district on Wednesday. The deceased were identified as Siyam, 5, son of Mostafizur Rahman, and Robius Sunny, 4, son of Joynal Abedin, a resident of the village. Family sources said the two fell into the pond while playing on its bank at around 1:00pm. Local people later rescued the boys and rushed them to the upazila health complex where attending doctors declared them dead.

### Jamaat leader arrested

Police arrested a union level leader of Jamaat-e-Islami at Baro Pathar village in Jakiganj upazila on Wednesday. The arrestee was identified as Abdul Jalil, 45, president of Birshri union unit of Jamaat. Officer-in-Charge of Jakiganj Police Station Safiqur Rahman Khan said acting on a tip-off, a team of police conducted a drive at the house of Jalil in the area and arrested him in the afternoon. The Jamaat leader was wanted in several cases, including one for assaulting police, the OC added.

### Minor girl raped, one arrested

A seven-year-old schoolgirl was raped allegedly by the imam of a local mosque at Birpakerdah village in Madarganj upazila on Wednesday.

The accused is Jahedul Islam, 35, imam of Birpakerdah Ahle Hadis Jame Mosque, and son of Badsha Miah of Nishchintapur village.

Police and locals said the second grader along with several other minor girls used to come to the mosque to learn Arabic from Jahedul.

After the Arabic class was over at around 6:00pm on Wednesday, the imam let all the learners except the victim go.

He then took the girl to his living room under the stairs of the mosque in the name of making the lesson easy and raped her, alleged Rampada Mandal, officer-in-charge of Madarganj Police Station.

As she cried for help, locals rushed to the spot, rescued the girl and caught the imam red-handed. They later handed him over to police after giving him a good beating.

The girl was sent to Jamalpur General Hospital for medical test.

The victim's mother filed a rape case under Women and Children Repression Prevention Act, said the OC.

## Most roads in Lalmonirhat municipality in awful state

Most roads in the municipality have become unfit for movement of traffic, resulting in suffering of the people.

Numerous potholes have developed on the roads because they have not been repaired for long.

These are BDR gate to Sakoya road, Madoner Chawk to Nayarhaat road, Baniya Deghee road, Namatari road, Shwashan Colony road, BDR Haat road, Sadhutari road, Adarshapara road, and Thana road.

BDR gate to Sakoya is one of the important roads of Lalmonirhat municipality, but it is now in sorry state. The road has become unfit for vehicular movement.

Mohor Ali, a resident of Muktiyoddha

Chattar, said people from different areas of the district use BDR gate to Sakoya road everyday as it is the gateway to the town. "The townspeople can't move easily on the road," he said.

Nazrul Islam, a battery-run easy-bike driver, said passengers face immense trouble while going through the road by the three-wheeler.

Azgor Ali of Uttar Saptana area said people in the municipality area can't move on the roads comfortably because potholes have developed on them.

Contacted, Mayor Reazul Islam Rintu said contractors have been selected through tenders for repair and extension of the roads. They will get work orders soon, the mayor added.
