Brief description of the assignment : The objective of the study is to provide consulting services for feasibility study and mine design for extension of existing underground mining operation of Barapukuria Coal Mine towards the southern and the northern side of the basin without interruption of the present production located at Chowhati, Parbatipur in Dinajpur district, Bangladesh. The study will include the followings:-

- Exploration planning, supervision and management of exploration activities which shall include 3-D seismic survey, borehole drilling, geological and geophysical logging, hydrogeological survey/works, lab analysis services etc. The firm may hire specialist for these works.
- Study of the previous data, topography;
- 3-D seismic survey (Area ±4.5 sq.km, target depth-350-450, shot point interval-10m, interval between two profiles-10m etc);
- Exploratory drilling (±15), geophysical and geological logging;
- Project feasibility study (which includes- EIA, EMP, Socio-economic impacts assessment);
- Assessment of resettlement requirements and preparation of a resettlement action plan;
- The determination of geological and hydrogeological conditions, mining method, actual reserve, yearly production rate, mine life;
- Detailed economic analysis and to determine if the project is economically viable or not;
- Lab analysis services;
- Computer generated 3-D geological model of the resources;
- Mine design (sufficient to tender for the construction of mine).

- d) have full time dedicated and qualified geologists, mining engineers, and geo-technical engineers.
