Prof Mahmuda Islam and Prof Tania Haque of Dhaka University (DU) talked about the lack of transparency of the DU's sexual harassment complaint committee and how political influence affected steps taken against perpetrators.
Mansur Ahmed Chowdhury, jury board member of ActionAid Bangladesh's Nasreen Smriti Padak, spoke on the culture of impunity.
Admitting the high prevalence of political influence, Annisul said, "Attitude of political parties needs to change. If they create pressure on police to take action, we can reach a solution."
At the programme's end, four women were awarded Nasreen Smriti Padak in memory of ActionAid Bangladesh's former country director and women's rights activist Nasreen Parvin Huq.
Dinomoni Tigya from Naogaon was awarded for creating change among young women, Rokhsana Khatun from Sirajganj for doing untraditional jobs, Shanti Malo from Joypurhat for resisting violence, and freedom fighter and sculptor Ferdousi Priyabhasini for her contribution in the Liberation War and arts. Dinomoni, Rokhsana and Shanti were chosen from 17 nominees from 28 districts.

health sector gets a meagre allocation in the national budget. "But we are achieving a lot with our small resources," he said.
UNFPA Representative in Bangladesh Argentina Matavel Piccin hailed the government's commitment for reducing maternal mortality.
She appreciated that 31 nursing intuitions and colleges are offering three-year diploma on midwifery.
However, issues like quality of education, creating demand for midwives in communities and promoting midwifery services need attention, she said.
She said as a large number of childbirths take place at homes, the demand for midwives should be created through promoting them as a brand and also creating awareness on the importance of having skilled birth attendants during delivery.
UNFPA consultant DR Syed Abu Jafar Md Musa pointed out that there is no system of accreditation to maintain the standard of midwifery education in the country.
The quality of education cannot be controlled without an accreditation authority in place, he said.
He emphasised that an estimation of the number of midwives required would be needed in coming years, and a plan on where the newly appointed midwives should be deployed must be formulated without any delay.
Monica Fong, technical officer for human resources at World Health Organization, said a mechanism for evaluating the midwifery graduates needs to be set up.
"The curriculums of midwifery are of international standard. But a way to evaluate the learning of midwives is still absent," she said.
She further said that women in general should be empowered to demand access to healthcare facilities during pregnancy and delivery.
Prof Dr Md Habibe Millat, MP, Goutam Aich Sarker, joint secretary to the health ministry, Dr Momena Khatun, senior health adviser of DFATD-Canada, and Prof Ferdousi Islam of Dhaka Medical College, spoke at the programme moderated by Piccin and Shahnoor Wahid, special supplements editor at The Daily Star.

SC upholds bail for BNP leader Nasir

The Supreme Court yesterday upheld the High Court orders granting BNP Human Rights Affairs Secretary Nasir Uddin Ashim bail in two vandalism and arson cases filed with Dhanmondi police on January 17 and February 3.
The SC passed "no order" on two appeals filed by the government seeking stay on the HC orders.
On May 10, Nasir got anticipatory bail for four weeks. Meanwhile, the HC granted anticipatory bail to another BNP leader Syeda Asifa Ashrafi Papiya for four weeks.

Jhpiego is looking for a qualified and motivated individual for working with MaMoni Health Systems Strengthening (HSS) Project for the post of Quality Improvement and Capacity-building (QI&CB) Manager to provide technical and programmatic support to strengthen maternal, newborn, child health, family planning and nutrition (MNCH/FPN) services. The main responsibility of the QI&CB Manager is to provide programmatic and technical support for the service delivery and quality improvement of integrated MNCH/FPN services in MaMoni HSS project areas. The Manager will support the introduction and scaling up of quality improvement interventions in assigned districts. S/he will work as members of the QI&CB and will contribute to developing QI tools and adapting them to the context in Bangladesh. His/her primary role would be to support district implementation team for quality improvement and MNCH/FPN capacity building activities while he/she will also serve as the project's focal person for family planning. S/he will support the capacity building of project staff and service providers in the public sector and in selected private sector. S/he will ensure analysis of quality of care data, prepare progress reports, and use data to take action to improve services. The position is based in Dhaka with extensive field travel to MaMoni HSS project districts. S/he will spend at least 60% time in the field supporting the implementation of project's programs.

M.B.B.S. Advanced public health or management degree is desirable. Minimum 5-year experience in program management/training in FP and MNCH programs. Strong experience and understanding of FP program in Bangladesh. Demonstrated experience in managing MNCH/FPN programs. Willingness to travel to underserved upazilas.
