They noted that land filling was a big challenge on two grounds. First is to fill up eight to 15 metres of land in places. Then the soil needs up to two years to compact so that installing heavy machinery would be safe and reliable," said another official.

The Maheshkhali site is within 10-15 kilometres of Matarbari where the coal-fired 1,200MW power project is being built with Japanese soft loan. The Matarbari plant comes with a massive \$4.5 billion price tag and it includes setting up of a deep sea port dedicated to handling imported coal.

For the power plants in Maheshkhali, the PDB has signed memorandums of understanding with Malaysia and China to set up two power plants, each with 1,320MW capacity. In April last year, the PDB signed an

MoU with Chinese company CHDHK and has finalised a joint venture agreement. In September, it signed an MoU with Malaysian Tenega and is now preparing for a feasibility study. Besides, the PDB is framing MoUs

with Korean company Kepko and a Singaporean company for two separate power plants.

The North West Power Generation Company has also signed an MoU with Chinese company CMC last year and has appointed a consultant to conduct a feasibility study for its 1,320MW coal power project.

Another 193 posts of lower court judges will fall vacant in few months, even though around 27 lakh cases are pending with lower courts across the country. The courts currently have around 1,500 judges.

Among the vacant posts, 263 are of senior assistant judges, 89 of joint district judges, 30 of additional district judges and 17 of district judges. The government has so far

appointed 930 assistant judges and judicial magistrates through the BJSC after the body was reconstituted in 2007, sources said. Law Secretary ASSM Zahirul

Haque Dulal said the new judges were appointed only at the entry level -- posts of assistant judge and judicial magistrate. Posts of other judges are filled

through promotions, and therefore, the vacant posts cannot be filled up at a time, he said.

FROM PAGE 16 alongside the usual lists of websites and news articles. For Twitter, it could increase the importance of the site to those who don't use it -- potentially bringing new users to register, as growth has stagnated. Clicking on the results on Google

takes users through to Twitter, where they can see the tweet in its context as well as exploring the rest of the topic.

A tie-up between Twitter and Google now means that tweets are being fed straight into Google as they are posted, meaning that Google doesn't have to send robots out to crawl over tweets and index them in its data. Instead, Google has been given access to Twitter's "firehose" -- the constant stream of tweets that it had access to before, until Twitter turned it off. In a blog announcing the change,

Google said that the update is "a great

thing is happening". "And it's another way for organisations and people on Twitter to reach a global audience at the most relevant moments," wrote Ardan Arac, a Google senior project manager. Twitter said that the change was an

attempt to make it "easier than ever to explore your interests across both Twitter and Google". Initial looks at the search seem to

indicate that Google is giving the tweets an extra boost in its rankings. Google's example search for "nasa twitter", for instance, shows the tweet results and pictures ahead of news and other results, and a search for Taylor Swift brings up her tweets before her official account. Most of those examples were celebrities or media events -- Taylor Swift and Mad Men were featured in both Twitter and Google's examples -apparently indicating that the companies intend for the feature to be used for
