Two held with fake notes

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested two youths with fake notes worth about Tk 1.2 lakh in Zianagar upazila of the district on Tuesday night. The arrestees are Sohag Sheikh alias Babu, 35, and Md Jahid Hossain, 32, of Balipara village. A team of Rab-8, acting on a tip-off, raided Aurapool area and arrested the two with fake notes of Tk 1,000, said Mizanul Haque, officer-in-charge of Indurkani Police Station in the upazila. The arrestees were produced in a court that sent them to jail yesterday, said the OC.

Trader commits 'suicide'

A local trader allegedly committed suicide at Dhanyakhola village in Sharsha upazila of Jessore district on Tuesday. The deceased was identified as Rinkon Hossain, 25, son of late Mizanur Rahman of the village. Family sources said Rinkon took a Tk 16 lakh loan for his business. However, he could not repay the loan as he suffered a loss in the business. Later, the lenders started putting pressure on him for the money which embarrassed him and his family members. Following this, Rinkon killed himself by taking poison on Tuesday night.

Drug peddler jailed

A mobile court sentenced a drug peddler to six months' imprisonment in the district town yesterday. The convict is Idrusur Rahman, 45, son of late Fazlur Rahman of Purahitpara area in the town. The court, led by Executive Magistrate Bibishan Kanti Das, in a drive arrested Idrusur with four Yaba tablets at noon. He was later sent to the district jail, said the court sources.

Youth found murdered

UNB, Sirajganj

Police recovered the body of a young man from a septic tank of his friend's house at Nimgachhi Khokshahat village in Raiganj upazila on Tuesday. The deceased was identified as Pankaj, 25, son of Samiron Roy, a resident of the village. Father of the deceased said Pankaj locked in an altercation with some of his friends over playing cricket a few days ago. Yusuf and Sharif, sons of Abdul Mazid of the area, called Pankaj out of his house on Saturday afternoon and since then Pankaj remained missing, he said. Later, Pankaj's father filed a complaint with Raiganj Police Station. Superintendent of Police Motaher Hossain said on secret information, a team of police raided the house of Yusuf in the area in the afternoon. Later, the law enforcers recovered the body from the septic tank. Police arrested Mazid in connection with the killing.

2 arrested with liquor



Foil conspiracy against Jumma people

Santu Larma urges at PCP rally in Bandarban town

Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) Regional Council Chairman Santu Larma yesterday urged the CHT people to be united to foil the conspiracy against the Jumma (hill) people.

Peace cannot be restored in CHT if a pro-people and progressive government is not established in the country, he said while inaugurating as the chief guest the 20th central council and 26th founding anniversary of Pahari Chhatra Parishad in the historic Rajar Math area of Bandarban town.

"Bangladesh has already enjoyed 43 years of independence but the people of the CHT region remain in a hopeless condition. The government has failed to properly implement the CHT peace accord 17 years

after its passing, and army is controlling the CHT areas," said Santu, also president of Parbatya Chattagram Jana Sanghati Samity.

The government's move to establish a medical college and science and technology university is nothing but a ploy to occupy the lands of Jumma people in the name of development, said the former guerrilla leader.

Urging the indigenous students and youths to take a firm stance against the prevailing situation, Santu said the government would be responsible for any unwarranted situation if it continues to work against the expectation of the hill

people.

Jyotishman Chakma, central president of Pahari Chhatra Parishad, presided over the function while Md Mahiuddin Mahin, assistant professor of Chittagong University, Abul Kalam Azad, president of Bangladesh Chhatra Moitri, Rehena Begum, councillor of Chittagong City Corporation, KS Mong Marma, member CHT Council, and Wai Ching Prue Marma, leader of Mohila Samity, were present as special guests.

After the programme, thousands of indigenous people paraded the main streets of the district town with placards, festoons, and banners.

Peon beats up school kids for protesting his indecent act

A peon severely beat up two Class V students of Pukuridanga Government Primary School in Panchagarh Sadar upazila as they protested his showing obscene videos to a few girls of the school on Tuesday afternoon.

The victims -- Imran Hossain, 11, son of Mozibar Rahman, and Zahid Hasan, 11, son of Jasim Uddin of Ambari village under the same upazila, are undergoing treatment at Panchagarh Sadar Hospital.

School peon Zakir Hossain was showing obscene videos to several girls of Class V in the office room around 2:30pm when the teachers were absent, locals said.

Sensing the matter, Imran and Zahid entered the office room and asked Zakir what he was doing. At this Zakir got angry and severely beat the two stu-

dents, leaving them injured. Hearing the matter, guardians and villagers rushed to the school and took the two students to Panchagarh Sadar Hospital. Meanwhile, Zakir managed to flee.

Imran's right hand got fractured and Zahid had several injury marks, hospital sources said.

Guardians Ashraf Ali, Hossain Ali and Moslem Uddin said peon Zakir Hossain is a drug addict and he often showed obscene videos to girl students of the school.

Demanding action against the peon, guardians of students demonstrated at the school premises yesterday afternoon.

Contacted over mobile, Md Faruk Hossain, headmaster of the school, said, "The teachers were in an enclave area for a survey work when the incident occurred. We will take action against Zakir Hossain through holding a meeting of the school managing committee."

Mominul Islam, officer in charge of Panchagarh Police Station, told this correspondent over cell phone that nobody filed any complaint in this connection as of filing of the report yesterday afternoon.

Shrimp fry seized
