'CAPTAIN AMERICA' FILM

Actor Mark Ruffalo has teased fans about his involvement in Marvel's upcoming movie, "Captain America: Civil War". The actor, who is famous as Hulk in "The Avengers" films, suggested on Twitter the popular character will be featured in the third 'Captain America' movie along with Marvel's other superheroes. "The Marvel family gets just a little bit bigger," he tweeted. He also posted a photo on Tumblr announcing the release date of the film. "Welcome to the wild party! Looking forward to this amazing cast," Ruffalo, 47, wrote. The Hulk will join Iron Man (Robert Downey Jr), Scarlet

Witch (Elizabeth Olsen), Black Widow (Scarlett Johansson), Falcon (Anthony Mackie), Black Panther (Chadwick Boseman), Agent Sharon Carter (Emily VanCamp), among others. The film centres on Captain America, who is against Iron Man over the issue of superhuman registration, and the film sparks the beginning of Marvel's much famed Civil War storyline. It will arrive on May 6, 2016 Stateside. Anthony and Joe Russo return as directors, Kevin Feige serves as producer, while Christopher Markus and Stephen McFeely team up as screenwriters.



**KATE BECKINSALE
IS RETURNING FOR
UNDERWORLD 5**

A reboot of the Underworld franchise is in the works, with a script from Cory Goodman (Priest). We didn't quite know what that meant for series star Kate Beckinsale who made her return for the fourth installment, a film which practically served as a soft reboot of the brand. Fortunately for fans of the series which began in 2003, both Kate Beckinsale and Theo James are indeed coming back. Lakeshore and Sony Screen Gems are still working away on another Underworld and are still using Goodman's script, which we can only assume wasn't really a reboot to begin with. Things got confusing when Len Wiseman, Beckinsale's husband and original director, announced at New York Comic-Con that a Beckinsale-focused sequel was happening separate from a spinoff with Theo James and that in addition to the two film projects, a TV series was also in the works. There's been no news since but what we now know for certain: Kate Beckinsale is locked in to return as the badass vampire warrior Selene and Theo James is currently attached as well since he was optioned for another from his contract for Underworld 4. There may just be one movie in development for the time being. Underworld 5 will likely release late 2016 or January 2017.

'White Collar' alum Matt Bomer has joined Denzel Washington and Chris Pratt in "The Magnificent Seven", a remake of the 1960 western film. The film centres on a woman (Haley Bennett), who hires a disparate group of gunslingers to protect her town from rampaging bandits that are led by a robber baron. Bomer will star as the woman's husband, a man who tries to stand up to the robber baron, said The Hollywood Reporter. Washington plays a bounty hunter, Pratt portrays a magician turned gambler, Vincent D'Onofrio stars as a mountain man, who used to be a killer, Wagner Moura will be seen as a caballero, Ethan Hawke as a sharpshooting war deserter and Jason Momoa as one of the villains. Antoine Fuqua directs the movie while John Lee Hancock rewrites the script which was originally written by "True Detective" writer Nic Pizzolatto. It is scheduled for a release on January 13, 2017.
