

# War crimes court orders treatment of sick suspect in jail

The International Crimes Tribunal-2 yesterday sent a sick war crimes suspect to jail, directing the jail authorities to provide him with medical treatment immediately, if necessary. Police yesterday produced Moulavi Samsuddoha, who was arrested on Sunday in Cox's Bazar, before the tribunal, but Samsuddoha, aged around 100 years, fell sick. The tribunal also directed the jail authorities to submit a report on Samsuddoha's health by June 2 and produce him before it on July 22, the next date fixed for the case. Samsuddoha is among 19 people of Maheshkhali upazila in Cox's Bazar linked to crimes committed against humanity during the Liberation War.

# Sust jeopardises Prothom Alo journo's exam despite HC order

The Shahjalal University of Science and Technology authorities yesterday initially barred a student from his semester final exam although the High Court has asked the Sust administration to let him take exams, the Prothom Alo reported. Munshy Md Misbah Uddin, a fourth year student of computer science and engineering and the Sust correspondent of the daily, was let into the exam centre about one hour past start of the exam. The Sust authorities' action amounts to contempt of court said Zahurul Islam Mukul, lawyer of Misbah, who sought legal recourse after being denied admission to the second semester of the fourth year on different excuses in April. On May 21, he went to the HC, and on May 24, the court asked the Sust authorities to let him take exams and continue his academic activities. Two years ago, in April 2013, the Sust administration had suspended Misbah without showing any grounds after the Prothom Alo published a report on violation of rules in recruitment of teachers at the university. Asked about yesterday's denial, head of the CSE department Md Shahidur Rahman said he could not allow Misbah to take exams because he was not admitted yet. SEE PAGE 5 COL 2

# RAPE OF 12-YR-OLD GIRL IN CTG HC orders Rangunia cops to arrest accused

The High Court yesterday directed Rangunia police to immediately arrest Shah Alam, resident of Chittagong who allegedly raped a 12-year-old girl with fake promise to marry her. Responding to a writ petition, the court also ordered the officer-in-charge of Rangunia Police Station to take appropriate legal action against Shah Alam, reportedly an influential resident of Shilok Minagazair Tila village, and to submit a report in this regard before it by June 15. The 12-year-old girl, a class-VII student, worked as a domestic help at Shah Alam's house temporarily and reportedly became pregnant a few days ago. According to a report published on May 23 in the Independent, the victim's mother lodged a rape case with Rangunia Police Station on May 8 against Shah Alam, 55. On May 8, police detained Shah Alam but

released him and later detained the victim, her brother and mother on that night. Moreover, police made the mother of the victim sign a blank paper under duress. Rangunia police produced the victim and her brother in the court after allegedly detaining them in the police station for two days. The victim, her mother and brother alleged that police filed the rape case where the brother of the victim was shown as the rapist, the report added. Yesterday, the HC also asked the Rangunia police to record a first information report based on the report and issued a rule upon the government to explain in four weeks why the refusal of Rangunia police to accept the case from the victim's mother should not be declared illegal. Supreme Court lawyer Jyotirmoy Barua filed the petition on Sunday following the report seeking HC orders to summon the Rangunia police officials including the OC for filing a fabricated case.

# Pirojpur magistrate, UNO summoned for making college teacher kneel down

HC also orders judicial probe, asks for explanation why legal action should not be taken against them

The High Court yesterday summoned the upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) and executive magistrate of Bhandaria of Pirojpur to appear before it on June 15 for forcing a college teacher to apologise by kneeling down before the magistrate during HSC examination on April 9 this year. In response to a writ petition filed by the teacher on May 24, the court also asked the chief judicial magistrate of Pirojpur to conduct an inquiry into the incident and report before it by June 15. After hearing the petition, the HC yesterday also issued a rule upon the government to explain in three weeks why the action of the UNO and the executive magistrate against the teacher should not be declared illegal and why it should not be ordered to take legal action against them. UNO Monir Hossain Hawlader and executive magistrate (assistant commissioner of land) Ashrafur Islam have to appear before the HC bench of Justice Quazi Reza-UI Hoque and Justice Abu Taher Md Saifur Rahman by 10:30am on June 15 to explain about the incident. Montaj Uddin, an assistant professor of a government college in Pirojpur, was discharging duty at Bhandaria Government College HSC examination centre on April 9. According to the writ petition, when magistrate Ashrafur entered the examination room, the teacher asked for his identity. At one stage of exchange of words, the magistrate phoned the UNO and called for police force in the exam centre. Later, the UNO and the magistrate compelled Montaj to apologise to the magistrate at the office room of the principal of the college. The incident was published in the media with photos.

# DRAFTING ACTION PLAN ON CHILD MARRIAGE Govt slammed for putting cart before horse

Women's rights activists yesterday criticised the government for forming a draft action plan on child marriage without specifying the minimum legal age of females for marriage. They urged the government not to form any action plans until the legal bar regarding age for marriage is settled. The activists under the banner "Shamajik Protirodh Committee" held a press conference in the capital's Jatiya Press Club also protesting the government's attempt to lower the minimum age of females for marriage from the existing 18 to 16. Mentioning Islamist group Hefajat-e-Islam, eminent educationist Rasheda K Chowdhury said there are groups of religious fanatics who are against women's education and economic progress. "Lowering girls' legal age for marriage would eventually serve their purpose," she said. Sultana Kamal, executive director of Ain o Salish Kendra, said, "The step [lowering the minimum age] would be suicidal for a country that has just begun to reduce maternal and child mortality and make progress in women's development indicators." Nari Progati Sangha Director Rokeya Kabir, citing a 2014 Unicef report, said 39 percent of Bangladeshi girls got married before their 15th birthday, the highest rate in the world, while 74 percent got married before the age of 18. Ranjan Karmakar, executive director of Step Towards Development, among others, spoke.
