BNP-Jamaat hartals, blockade adversely affected SSC results

Says Hasina after Nahid presents grades

UNB, Dhaka

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday said results would have been much better if the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and equivalent exams had not been affected by hartals and the blockade the BNP-Jamaat-e-Islami alliance enforced. "Examinees faced serious trouble during the SSC exams due to frequent shifting of their exam schedules," she said after Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid handed over the results of 10 education boards to her at Gono Bhaban.
