

# Rab arrests three human traffickers

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab)-4 members yesterday arrested three "human traffickers" in the capital's Pallabi Kafrol on complaints of two victims.

The arrestees are Wasim Akhter (Nayan), 27, of Satkhira district, Jamal Sarker, 32, of Brahmanbaria, and Siddiqur Rahman (Shishir), 42, of Dhaka's Mirpur.

At a press briefing at Rab headquarters yesterday, Md Rakib Khandker, 25, of Patuakhali district, said the duo promising fake jobs at a painting factory in India's Chennai, trafficked four people including him and Md Habib, 26, of Dinajpur, to Tamil Nadu through Satkhira border on March 18.

They were confined to a jungle where they worked loading sacks without pay for two months. The gang beat and starved them if they refused to work. One day, Rakib, Habib and one other victim escaped from Tamil Nadu, and Habib and Rakib complained to Rab-4.

The arrestees told reporters that they sent the victims from Dhaka to Satkhira, taking Tk 2,000 from each, to another gang who later sent them to India.

Rab officials claimed the gang sold the four to one Moniruzzaman Dalim in India.

# HC clears way for CU senate meeting to elect VC

The High Court yesterday cleared the way for holding the senate meeting of Chittagong University to form a panel to elect its vice-chancellor.

The court yesterday rejected a writ petition filed on May 14 by three teachers of the university in which they mentioned that the university authorities without forming the senate lawfully were going to form a VC panel at a meeting scheduled for May 23.

Following the petition, the court earlier issued a rule upon the authorities to explain why the constitution and continuation of the existing senate of CU should not be declared illegal and stayed the meeting.

Petitioners' counsel MK Rahman yesterday said he was yet to get instruction from his clients about moving an appeal before the Supreme Court against the HC verdict.

# CCC to pull down illegal billboards from today

Chittagong City Corporation (CCC) will launch a drive to pull down the illegal billboards in the city from today, CCC magistrate Najia Shirin told The Daily Star.

On May 25, at a meeting with officials of revenue department of CCC, Mayor AJM Nasir Uddin declared to remove all illegal billboards. The meeting informed that a total of 1,033 billboards are illegal now in the city.

# Health, social costs outweigh tax revenue from tobacco

MANAS discussion told marking World No Tobacco Day

The revenue generated by taxing tobacco industries is not cost effective for Bangladesh as it is always outweighed by health and social costs, anti-tobacco campaigners told a discussion yesterday.

"Increase tax on tobacco. It may reduce healthcare spending," said Jatiya Sangsad Speaker Shirin Sharmin Chaudhury. Increasing tax will reduce consumption and revenue, but the resulting drop in healthcare cost would benefit the state, she added.

Shirin also hailed the government for enacting a tobacco control act but

Justice Md Mozibur Rahman Miah and Justice Md Shahinur Islam fixed July 22 to hear on the charges.

Meanwhile, the prosecution continued placing closing arguments in the case against Forkan Mallik, an alleged Razakar of Patuakhali's Mirzaganj upazila facing five charges including murders and rapes.

Prosecutor Mukhlesur Rahman Badal completed placing arguments citing prosecution witnesses' testimonies on the first two charges over the killing of three people and forcing three Hindu brothers to convert to Islam.

The tribunal adjourned proceedings until today.

Meanwhile, a fourth prosecution witness linked Obaidul Haque Taher and Aatur Rahman Nani to the abduction and murders of several people in Netrakona's Barhatta upazila during the Liberation War.

Nabi Newaz Talukder of Laufa village, the seventh to testify in the case centring six charges, elaborately described the incident that took place on the first day of the Bangla month of Kartik. The previous three gave similar descriptions.

The three-member International Crimes Tribunal-1 led by Justice M Enayetur Rahim adjourned proceedings until today, when Nabi will be cross-examined by the defence.
