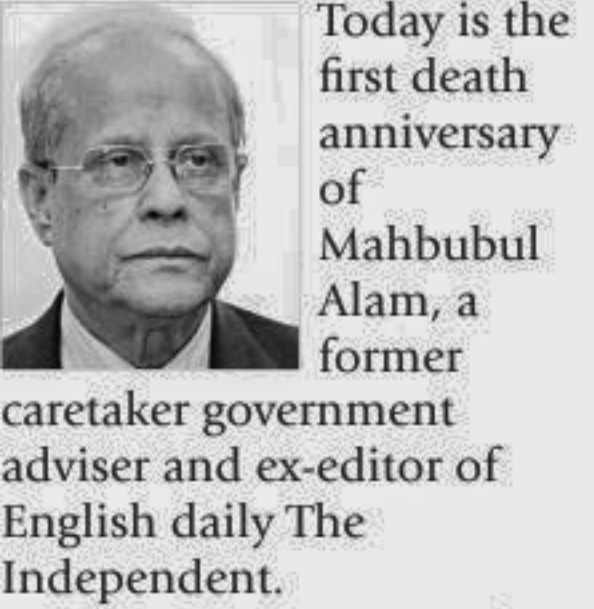


**Journo Mahbubul Alam's death anniversary today**

**Import duty on sugar to be cut**

Muhith tells press, hints changes in individuals' income tax

The proposed additional customs duty on imported sugar will be withdrawn, said Finance Minister AMA Muhith yesterday, also hinting on changing the proposed minimum income tax rate for individuals.

At a post-budget press conference in the capital's Osmani Memorial Auditorium, Muhith first denied raising the duty but was informed by NBR Chairman Md Nojibur Rahman that it was a mistake that would be corrected through parliament.

**Foul play suspected over trader's death**

An unnatural death case was filed with the capital's Shahbagh Police Station yesterday centring the death of a trader whose family suspects that a police sub-inspector (SI) poisoned him over a dispute over investment.

Nur-e-Alam Azad Sourad died two and a half hours after being brought unconscious to Dhaka Medical College Hospital around 4:30pm on Thursday by two unidentified men who fled, said Assistant Sub-inspector Sentu Chandra Das of the hospital's police outpost. **BSF for legalising cattle trade**

Although India has asked its border guards to stop smuggling of cattle into Bangladesh, a write-up in the Indian Force magazine has suggested that the only way to tide over the problem is "legalising export of over-aged and non-milching animals" and "promoting beef industry in India" by allowing their slaughter.

The central government of India is dedicated to the protection of beef, with some states banning cow slaughter. However, the BSF is of the view that it is time to take a practical approach, with respect for the cultural sensitivity of India.

In its official magazine, BSF's DIG (intelligence) SP Tiwari, who is posted in the South Bengal frontier and deals with the menace of cattle-smuggling daily, has made these suggestions while acknowledging that over two million cattle are smuggled to Bangladesh every year.

Bangladesh has been pleading India to legalise cattle trade across the border as it is a huge industry in the country. Even BSF officers say in private that preventing cattle smuggling should be taken out of its charter of duties as it diverts attention from the more important job of preventing infiltration and smuggling of fake Indian currency notes and contraband. "The joke in the force is that we are not BSF - Border Security Force - but CSE, Cattle Security Force," says a senior BSF officer.

Among other suggestions mentioned in the magazine are opening cattle haats in bordering areas for limited sale of cattle to Bangladesh; legalising cattle export for agricultural purposes and helping Bangladesh develop animal husbandry; and a total ban on slaughter of cattle in India by enactment of law by the government of India.

**CJ starts probe into 'murder accused-judge contact'**

Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha has appointed an Administrative Tribunal member to investigate allegations that a Chandpur judge who exempted two murder case accused had been contacted by one over the telephone 22 times.

AR Masud on Thursday has been asked to submit the report as early as possible, a Supreme Court source told The Daily Star yesterday.

It was based on an application submitted at the chief justice's office on May 31 by the plaintiff, Tawfiq Azim Mishu, added the source.

In it, Tawfiq mentioned that call lists show that Mohammad Ehsan had the phone communications with District and Sessions Judge Md Mafizul Islam between March 17 and April 15.

Police in separate drives arrested four persons for their alleged involvement in human trafficking in Cox's Bazar yesterday, reports our Cox's Bazar correspondent.

They are Hosne Ara Reshmi, Mohammad Mostafa, Mohammad Alam and Abdul Jalil.

Meanwhile, a team of Rab-3 held an alleged human trafficker, Tanaim Islam Chowdhury Kiron, in the capital's Mirpur yesterday, said a press release. Rab also seized 17 passports, some forged medical certificates, and a cheque of Tk 9 crore from him.

Rab arrested Abdul Haque on charge of human trafficking in Chittagong city, reports our Chittagong correspondent.

around 9:30pm.

Security personnel will restrict traffic on those roads for a longer period than they usually do during the trips of the Bangladesh prime minister, said a top traffic police official, preferring anonymity.

"But we will tighten security on roads if the Special Security Force asked us to do so," he added.

Tomorrow, Modi will visit the Dhakeshwari Temple in Lalbagh, Ramkrishna Mission in Gopibagh, Indian High Commission in Baridhara, and the Bangabhaban. He is expected to leave Dhaka at 8:20pm.

Security in the city has already been tightened ahead of Modi's visit.

"Apart from the law enforcement agencies, the city leaders of the ruling Awami League will remain alert to any trouble," said a deputy commissioner of Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP).

Street vendors in several areas of the capital have been evicted from footpaths. Law enforcers also set up check posts on roads, said police.

SM Jahangir Alam Sarker, acting deputy commissioner (media) of DMP, said they already planned to ensure tight security measures in and around the airport and in places Modi would visit. Top DMP officials were co-ordinating the measures.

The Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) will deploy bomb disposal teams and dog squads at the venues. They will set up additional check posts on roads. Besides, Rab men on motorcycles will patrol the key areas, said Mufti Mahmud Khan, legal and media wing director of Rab.

During his stay in Dhaka, Modi will be under the security cover of the Indian Special Protection Group and commando force Black Cat.

Indian security and protocol officials are already in the city. They had several meetings with the law enforcement agencies and the protocol unit of the foreign ministry.
