issued the arrest warrants after accepting the charges against 42 BNP leaders and activists, including the 27 wanted in the Mirpur arson case.

The court directed the officer-in-charge of Mirpur Police Station to submit reports by July 8 on execution of arrest warrants.

On April 22, Mirpur police pressed charges against the 42 BNP-led alliance men. Of the accused, eleven BNP men, including Rizvi Ahmed and Mosaddak Ali Falu, are now in jail while 27 others, including Rafiqul and Shimul Biswas, are absconding. Four others, including Advocate Syeda Asifa Ashrafi Papiya, are on bail.

Metropolitan Magistrate Asaduzzamn Nur took cognizance of the charges against Fakhrul, Moudud and 24 others in the Paltan vandalism case. On May 11, the investigation officer submitted the charge sheet against them.

## Road crashes kill 6, injure 8

Six people were killed and eight others injured in road accidents in five districts yesterday and Saturday.

In the capital, Ramjan Ali, 70, a resident of Lalbagh area was killed when a bus hit him at Shahbagh intersection yesterday.

Meanwhile in Asad Gate area Rafiqul Islam, a security guard, was killed when a three-wheeler hit him.

In Bogra, Abul Hossain Mondal, 70, of B-Block area was killed as he was run over by a vehicle in the area on Bogra-Dhaka highway in Shajahanpur upazila yesterday.

In Mymensingh, Kanai Goshwami, 40, of Muktagacha upazila was killed when his CNG-run auto-rickshaw collided head-on with a truck on Mymensingh-Tangail road at Satrasia in the upazila on Saturday.

In Rangpur, Sultana Khatun, 17, of Mirbagh area was killed and seven others were injured when an ambulance collided head-on with a three-wheeler on Rangpur-Kurigram highway in Mohesha area of Kaunia upazila yesterday.

In Natore, Rion Hossain, of Kholabaria village was killed and his co-rider injured in a head-on collision between his motorcycle and a Power-tiller in Patul area of Naldanga upazila yesterday.

The projects are India-Bangladesh Maitri Girls Hostel at Government Victoria College at Narail, construction of the third floor of Blind Education and Rehabilitation Development Organisation at Mirpur in Dhaka, sewage treatment plant and waste water treatment plant at Kumudini Hospital in Mirzapur, Tangail, and establishment of the Hindi department at the Institute of Modern Languages, recording studio for the music department and grant assistance for the dance department of DU.

He also donated two ambulances to freedom fighters.

The Indian premier then moved to Bangabhaban at 12:40pm and talked to President Abdul Hamid for about 15 minutes, hoping that all pending bilateral issues would be settled like the land boundary issue.

"Had a wonderful meeting with President Abdul Hamid at Bangabhaban," Modi tweeted.

Modi also received the Bangladesh Liberation War Honour award from President Hamid on behalf of former Indian premier Atal

Bihari Vajpayee.

In the afternoon, he met political and business leaders at Sonargaon hotel.

"Full spectrum outreach concludes with PM @narendramodi's meeting with Begum Khaleda Zia, former PM of Bangladesh," the Indian spokesperson, Vikas, tweeted.

Modi also met opposition leader Raushan Ershad, and delivered a lecture at a public gathering at Bangabandhu International Conference Centre.

He left Dhaka at 8:20pm.

**Background**  
BRAC, a nonprofit NGO, since its inception in 1972 has been working with people whose lives are dominated by extreme poverty, illiteracy, disease and calamities. BRAC, a Principal Recipient (PR) in close collaboration with Sub-Recipients (SR) has been implementing Tuberculosis and Malaria programmes in Bangladesh, funded by Global Fund (GF). BRAC is going to select auditors/audit firms for consolidated external audit of GF fund supported programmes.

Eligible interested audit firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures; description of similar assignments; experience in similar conditions, for similar projects and in developing countries; general qualifications and availability of appropriate skills among staff etc). The minimum requirements for an auditor of a GF grant are as follows:

- The auditor must be an independent firm, free from conflicts of interest with BRAC
- The auditor must be included on an accredited list of auditors of a recognised donor (for example, World Bank, USAID, European Commission, Embassy of the Kingdom of Netherlands)
- The auditor must be included on the list of enlisted CA firms for NGO-MFIs, Bangladesh Bank, Bangladesh Securities and Exchange Commission
- The auditor must be professionally competent and have experience in planning and conducting audits of this nature
- The auditor must be eligible to practice as an external auditor and express audit opinions pursuant to the laws, rules and other requirements of Bangladesh where the grant is implemented
- The auditor must be aware of the GF's code of conduct for suppliers and must comply with its provisions
- The auditor must have experience in applying International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), International Standards on Auditing (ISA) and International Accounting Standards (IAS)
- The Auditor must be able to employ adequate staff with appropriate professional qualifications and suitable experience with IFRS, ISA and IAS including experience in auditing the accounts of entities comparable in size and complexity to the entity being audited
- The auditor must have global affiliations and associations

BRAC intends to get the financial statements of GF supported programmes audited by auditors.
