# Cracks appear before handing over of new building

Cracks developed at 16 points and six pillars subsided before handing over of the newly constructed building of Kazirhat Police Station in Muladi upazila under the district.

After hearing the matter, Barisal district Superintendent of Police Aktaruzzaman visited the spot on May 27.

"Finding the building risky, I asked Public Works Department (PWD) authorities to repair it before handing over," he said.

Shawkat Anwar, officer in charge (OC) of Kazirhat Police Station, said Tipu Sultan, a contractor of Barisal city, started construction of the two-storied building at a cost of Tk 2.88 crore in 2012.

"The then home minister Mohiuddin Khan Alamgir inaugurated the new police station on September 11 in 2013 although the building was under construction.

"The police station is functioning at an abandoned house at Kazirhat

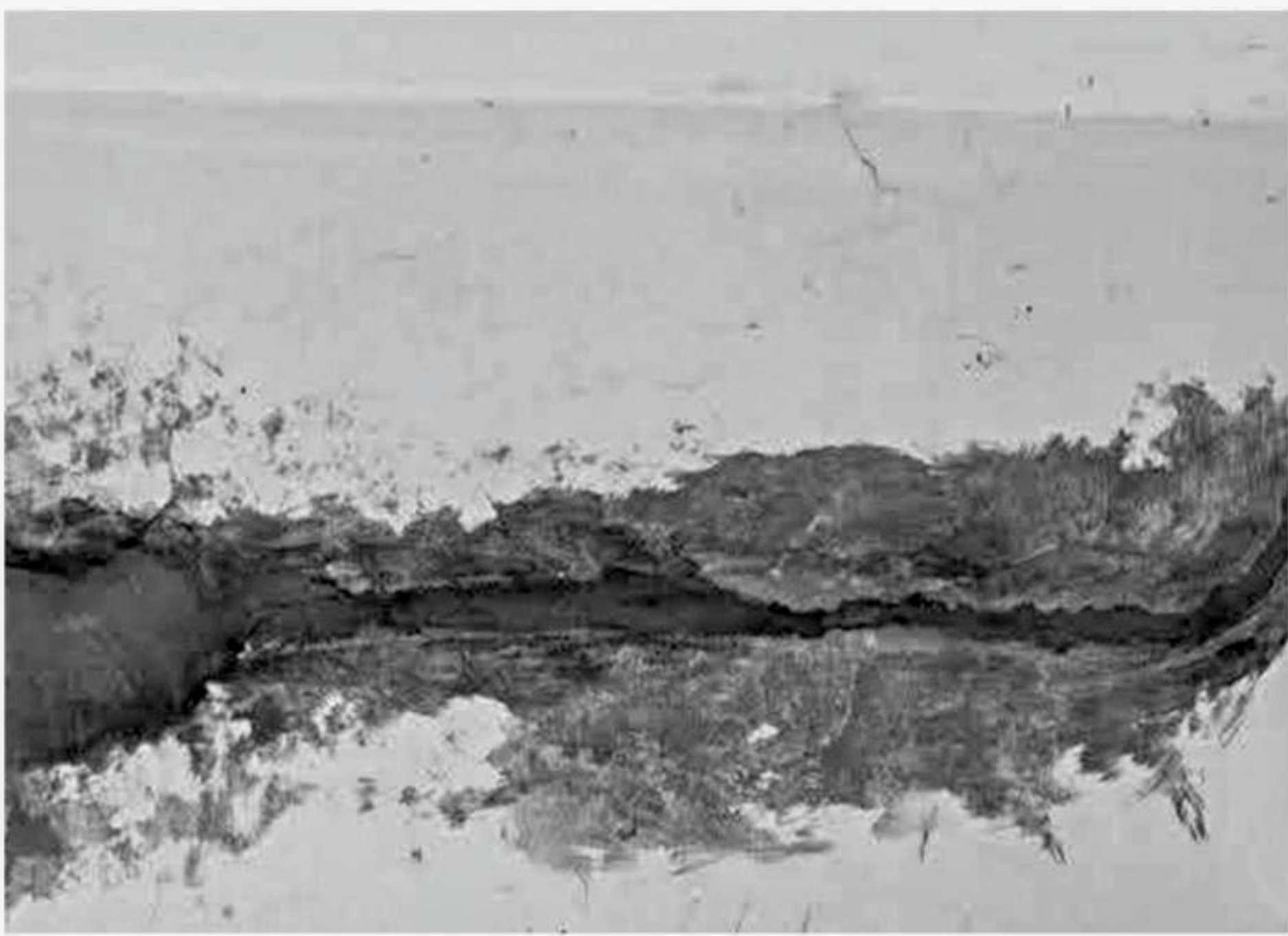

Bazar amid difficulties.

"Meanwhile, the construction work went on at a slow pace with substandard materials and the building has not been handed over to the police although the

scheduled time expired in June 2014," the OC said.

Contacted, Zakir Hossain, executive engineer of PWD, Barisal, said, "Although some problems appeared

before completion of the construction there is no major risk factor at the building structure. The contractor has been asked to repair the faults before handing it over."

# Downpour disrupts normal life of Mymensingh townspeople

A three-hour downpour disrupted normal life in the district town yesterday.

Train service on Mymensingh-Jamalpur route was disrupted for about three hours as rail tracks went under water.

Due to the rainfall, a big tree was uprooted in Kanchijuly area of the town, disrupting road communication between Mymensingh and Tangail for about four hours, said Md Kamrul Islam, officer-in-charge of Kotwali Police Station.

The authorities of at least 15 schools suspended their examinations in the town as classrooms were inundated following the heavy rain, said locals.

Around 84 millimetres rain was recorded in Mymensingh in three hours till noon, according to Bangladesh Meteorological Department.

Intercity Teesta Express left for Jamalpur at 1:20pm after a three-hour halt at Mymensingh station as rail lines in the area were inundated by the rain water, said stationmaster Abu Taher.

"We have suspended all sorts of examinations as rainwater entered the school," said Md Yunus Faruque, headmaster of

Mymensingh Government High School, adding that many students have failed to reach the schools as the rain inundated their houses.

Half yearly and pretest examinations were scheduled to be held in two shifts yesterday but the authorities were forced to suspend the examinations due to the heavy rain.

# Lightning kills 7 in five districts

Seven people were killed by lightning in Bogra, Jessore, Mymensingh, Manikganj and Chapainawabganj districts yesterday and the day before.

Our Bogra correspondent reported that two people were killed by lightning in Dhunat and Nandigram upazilas of the district yesterday.

The victims are Rafiqul Islam, 30, of Pakrihata village in Dhunat upazila, and Jamuli Roy, 28, wife of Nitai Roy of Hatkoroi village in Nandigram upazila.

In Jessore, Abdul Hamid Fakir, 50, and his son Huraia Fakir, 16, were struck by a thunderbolt at Gobindapur village in Keshabpur upazila of Jessore yesterday afternoon. They died on the spot, reports our Benapole correspondent.

# Robber gang leader killed in 'gunfight' with cops

The ringleader of an inter-district robber gang was killed in a 'gunfight' with police at Kanaipur in Sadar upazila early yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Selim Sheikh, 30, of Madhukhali upazila of the district.

Receiving information that a gang of robbers was taking preparation to commit robbery in the area, a team of police conducted a drive in the area around 3:30am.

Sensing the presence of the team, the robbers opened fire, prompting the law enforcers to retaliate.

At one stage, Selim received bullets and died on the spot while others managed to flee, police sources said.

A sub-inspector of Kotwali Police Station, was also injured in the incident, sources said, adding that police recovered one shutter gun, one pistol and a bullet from the spot.

Selim was wanted in several cases filed with Bhanga and Sadar police station in the district, police said.

# Lessee builds permanent structures on WDB land

An influential person has started building permanent structures, occupying a land owned by Water Development Board (WDB) near Alipur fish landing station under Kalapara upazila of the district.

Md Shahidul Islam, deputy assistant engineer of Kalapara WDB, sent a letter to the officer-in-charge of Kalapara Police Station on Wednesday to take legal steps against Amir Hossain Howlader, son of late Ali Akbar Howlader of Alipur, to recover the land.

WDB sources said Amir

Hossain leased 1.40 acres of wetland in Alipur on October 22, 2014 for three years for fish cultivation. According to terms and conditions, he couldn't build any permanent structure on the land, but he started building permanent structures on June 7.

Amir Hossain is building permanent structures on the land instead of cultivating fish, Md Shahidul Islam said. "We asked him to stop construction work but he continued, defying the order," he added.

During a visit to the area on Thursday, this correspondent found at least 10 labourers building perma-

nent structures.

"Other people might occupy government land if WDB does not take immediate steps against the grabber," said Masud Farazee, a local resident.

Md. Abul Khayer, executive engineer of Kalapara WDB, said a lessee is constructing structures on the land, ignoring the condition for lease. We have sent a letter to the police seeking legal steps in the matter, he added.

The local police station did not take any step against Ali Akbar as of yesterday. Contacted, Azizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Kalapara Police Station, said they are investigating the matter.

### Schoolgirl commits 'suicide'

A schoolgirl allegedly committed suicide at Dhormogram village in Atgoria upazila on Friday. The deceased was identified as Rupa Khatun, 15, daughter of Rafikul Islam of Chandpur village. Police said the ninth grader went out of the house on Friday evening following an altercation with her family members. Later, she took her life by hanging herself from a tree inside a graveyard in the area. On information, police rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Pabna General Hospital morgue for autopsy.

### Man found dead

Police recovered the body of an unidentified man from a sugar cane field in Kaharol upazila of the district on Friday. Locals found the body at the field in the area around 8:00pm and informed the police. The law enforcers rushed to the spot, recovered the body and sent it to Dinajpur Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy. Criminals might have strangled the man and dumped the body in the area, police said.

### Trader robbed of Tk 64 lakh

Criminals took away Tk 64 lakh from a crockery trader at Jhilpara in Gobindaganj upazila of the district on Friday night. Officer-in-Charge Jahidul Islam of Gobindaganj Police Station said a gang intercepted crockery trader Kamal Hossain when he along with his brother-in-law Liton was going to his house in the area around 10:00pm. They snatched a bag containing Tk 64 lakh from Kamal and stabbed Liton as he tried to resist the gang members. Police arrested three people-Manik, Pervez and Murad-for their alleged involvement in the incident.

### Polytechnic student drowns

A student of Jessore Polytechnic Institute drowned in the River Bhairab at Nawapara industrial town in the district yesterday morning. Police and locals said Naim along with his friends went to take a bath in the river and drowned.
