SC upholds HC stay on Islamic Foundation pesh imam hiring

The Supreme Court yesterday upheld a High Court's stay on the process of recruiting Pesh Imam for Islamic Foundation Bangladesh.

Chamber Judge of the Appellate Division Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain also asked the government to submit a leave to appeal before the SC against the HC order in two weeks after hearing a petition filed by the government.

On May 4, the HC stayed the recruitment for next three months following a writ petition filed by an aspirant for the post, Abdur Rahim of Gazipur, saying that the conditions of the foundation's circular for the post were contrary to its service rules, 1998.

Newlyweds found hanging in capital

A newlywed couple was found hanging from a hook of the ceiling of their tin-shed house at Badda Anandanagar in the capital yesterday.

Neighbours last saw Md Shahin, 22, around 8:00am when he went to an outdoor washroom. Later, receiving no response from inside the house, the neighbours peeped in and saw the hanging bodies.

Badda police sent the bodies of Shahin, an employee of a local furniture shop, and his wife Ruby, 19, to Dhaka Medical College morgue for autopsy. Police could not ascertain the reason behind the deaths.

similar charges but got out on bail, said detectives. According to detectives, the counterfeit cash operation takes place in three phases. One group prepares and supplies the papers, another prints those and the third circulates those purchasing goods in markets.

Additional Deputy Commissioner (DB South) Saiful Islam said producing Tk 1 lakh in fake notes costs between Tk 3,000 and Tk 3,500. The spurious notes are sold to wholesalers for Tk 12,000 who then sell to retailers for Tk 15,000 to Tk 25,000, he said.

Barrister Nawmi Naz Chowdhury of Bangladesh Legal Aid and Services Trust (BLAST) mentioned the lack of coordination among the government's helpline service, victim support centre, and onestop crisis centre.

"When a victim calls the helpline number, she is often asked to contact the nearest police station but not a victim support centre which also can record a complaint," she said.

Khushi Kabir, Nijera Kori's coordinator, said the case relating to the abduction of indigenous women's leader Kalpana Chakma, which has been pending for 19

Adivasis. She also said the government must be pressurised to deliver on its promises before the next UPR in 2017.

Prof Mizanur Rahman, chairman of National Human Rights Commission, urged the government to establish a separate land commission for "plain land indigenous communities" and fully implement the Chittagong Hill Tracts peace accord.

A report titled "State of UPR Progression 2014 Bangladesh's Indigenous People's Perspective" was launched at the programme where Prothom Alo Joint Editor Sohrab Hasan also spoke.
