Patients suffer as CT scan machine lies inoperative

The only CT scan machine at Mymensingh Medical College Hospital (MMCH) has remained inoperative for about eight months, much to the suffering of patients.

The patients have to pay more money to get the examination done at private diagnostic centres outside the hospital.

Hospital sources said the machine worth about Tk 10 crore was installed at the 1,000-bed MMCH in 2006. It will take around Tk 50 lakh to repair, they added.

Every day, around 40 patients, mainly from Neuro-medicine, Medicine and Orthopaedic Departments, are advised to undergo CT scan, said an employee at the Radiology and Imaging Department of MMCH. The test is very important, but we cannot render service to the patients, he added.

MMCH is the only hospital in Mymensingh region that has a CT scan machine, so serious patients from Jamalpur, Tangail, Sherpur, Netrakona and Kishoreganj are referred to the hospital for CT scan.

The examination used to cost around Tk 2,200 at MMCH, while it costs around Tk 3,500 to 4,000 at private diagnostic centres, sources said. Sometimes it is difficult to take serious

patients to diagnostic centres outside the hospital, said attendants of some patients undergoing treatment at MMCH.

"As head of the department, I wrote to the hospital director several times, but the machine is yet to be repaired or a new one procured," said Prof Dr Misbah Uddin Ahmed, head of Radiology and Imaging Department. A doctor at MMCH said

his father was admitted to the hospital in a critical condition in January this year, and he needed CT scan. "I had to take him outside the hospital pushing a trolley myself," he added.

Taking advantage of the situation, brokers of the clinics are inducing patients at MMCH to shift to their respective clinics, said a hospital source.

Engineer Abul Kalam, secretary of Mymensingh

Nagorik Andolon, said the hospital must provide all-out treatment facilities for the patients. "The hospital authorities should immediately repair the CT scan machine," he added.

Contacted, MMCH Director, Brig Gen Fasiur Rahman, said several letters have been sent to the ministry concerned to repair the machine but to no avail.

Human trafficker held in Pabna

Police arrested a human trafficker at Khoynan village in Sujanagar upazila on Saturday night.

The accused is Baser Mallik, 55, said Md Habibur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Sujanagar Police Station, adding that he was arrested on charge of trafficking five youths of the area to Malaysia about three months ago.

The victims are Milon Hossain, Babu Ali, Nazmul Hossain, Haque Mallik and Alhaz Hossain. Aged between 30 and 35 years, they hail from Khoynan and Bhaina villages.

The five endured inhuman physical and mental torture in a boat for around two months at sea.

They were repatriated from Myanmar on June 8 and then returned to their village homes on Thursday.

During primary interrogation, Baser confessed to trafficking the youths and gave information about some traffickers of Chittagong and Teknaf areas, said the OC.

Lightning kills one

3 trafficked boys reunite with parents after years

Three teenage boys, earlier trafficked to India, returned to the country and reunited with their parents at Hili land port in Hakimpur upazila under the district yesterday.

Indian immigration officials handed over the three boys -- Monir Khan, 16, of Narayanganj, Akramuddin, 17, of Joypurhat, and Nipun Mondal, 16, of Brahmanbaria to Md Rafiquzzaman, officer in charge (OC-Immigration) of Hili yesterday noon.

Delhi police rescued Monir Khan, then an eight-year-old boy, from a trafficking gang in 2006, said Suruj Das, co-coordinator of Suvayon Home, a correction centre in Balurghat of West Bengal.

"The panicked boy was kept in an observation centre in Delhi following a court order. Later he was sent to Suvayon Home. After a long wait, we have been able to find out Monir's parents," he said.

Monir's father Md Shahjahan Khan, hailing

from Postkula village under Kadamtoli upazila in Narayanganj, thanked the governments of both the counties for arranging return of his son.

Akramuddin and Nipun Mondal were also handed over to their parents yesterday, said Hili Immigration OC Rafiquzzaman.

The two boys had been arrested by Dakkhin Dinajpur police in 2012 and 2013 respectively and subsequently sent to Suvayon Home following court directives, he said.

Two Indians arrested with 46 gold bars

Two Indian nationals were arrested along with 46 gold bars weighing 4.6 kilograms at Indian Petrapole check post, opposite to Benapole check post under Jessore district on Saturday.

The identity of the arrestees could not be

known immediately, said Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) sources.

Benapole immigration sources said they came to Jessore from Dhaka by air. After finishing their official procedures regarding passport, they reached Indian Petrapole check post.

On secret information, Indian police raided the

area and arrested the two on Saturday night.

They also seized the gold bars from their shoes and cellphones, said Abdur Rahim, nayeb subedar of 26, BGB camp in Benapole check post.

Uttam Kumar Somaddar, revenue officer of Benapole custom check post, confirmed the incident.

Housewife strangled, another kills herself

A housewife was killed allegedly by her husband at Khamarkandi village in Sherpur upazila of the district on Saturday night.

The deceased is Joynab Begum, 25, daughter of Tamiz Uddin of the village.

Victim's brother Ansar Ali said Joynab's husband Abdur Rouf, a resident of the same village, used to torture his sister over trifling matter since their marriage three years back.

The couple had an altercation over lighting a candle during a power-cut around 9:00pm.

At one stage, Rouf strangled Joynab. He took her to Sherpur Upazila Health Complex and told doctors that she tried to commit suicide by hanging herself from a ceiling of their house. The doctors at the hospital declared her dead.

Receiving a complaint from the victim's family,

police recovered the body and sent it to Shaheed Ziur Rahman Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

Away in Thakurgaon, police recovered the body of a newlywed housewife from Kaharpara village in Sadar upazila on Saturday night.

The deceased is Anju Ara, 25, wife of Dulu Hossain, 32, a resident of the village, reports our correspondent.

Quoting local people police said the couple got married just a few months ago. After returning home from a local market around 8:00pm, the couple had an altercation over buying a saree. At one stage, Dulu went out of his house for a cup of tea at a nearby tea stall.

Around 9:00pm, Anju hanged herself from the ceiling of her room with a scarf.

Nilufa Begum, mother of the deceased, however, claimed that Anjur was often tortured by her in-laws' for dowry.

Teacher's brutality lands kid at hospital

Ruthlessly beaten by a teacher, a Class II student of Oxford Model School in Chuadanga town is undergoing treatment at Chuadanga Sadar Hospital.

While taking class on Saturday, teacher Anwarul Haq Jhantu, also a founder director of the school, asked Class II student Sakib-ul-Hasan to submit his handwriting copy, school sources said.

As Sakib was a bit late to obey, the teacher got angry and started hitting the boy with a scale.

Seeing the horrific sight of non-stop beating, many students ran out from the classroom.

Other teachers rushed in, rescued a bleeding Sakib, and took him to Chuadanga Sadar Hospital where he was

given four stitches on the forehead.

Hearing the incident, guardians of the students rushed to the school and confined

At one stage, the angry guardians started beating Jhantu.

He managed to run away from the scene.

Informed, a team from Chuadanga Sadar Police

Station rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

Sakib's father Aslam Hossain filed a case with Chuadanga Sadar Police against Jhantu.

Contacted, Chuadanga Sadar Upazila Nirbahi Officer AKM Mamunuzzaman, said, "I have asked police to take necessary action regarding the incident. I am on leave now but I am looking into the matter."

Meanwhile, a section of people led by the local union parishad chairman are allegedly trying to 'settle' the matter through local arbitration.

Liakat Hossain, officer in charge of Sadar Police Station, told this correspondent over phone that police was trying to arrest the absconding accused.

Child marriage bid foiled

A schoolgirl was saved from underage marriage following timely intervention of the local administration at Chandanpat village in Aditmari upazila of the district on Saturday.

Family sources said marriage of Hari Priya Rani, 13, a class five student of Chandanpat Government Primary School, and daughter of Shiben Chandra Roy of the village, was arranged on Saturday night.

Being informed, Upazila Nirbahi Officer Jahurul Islam along with police rushed to the spot and stopped the marriage.

However, the girl's parents, relatives and bridegroom managed to flee the scene, sensing the presence of the UNO and the law enforcers. Local police confirmed the incident.
