19 robbers arrested in Tangail, Barisal

Nineteen robbers were arrested in Tangail and Barisal districts yesterday and the day before.

In Tangail, police arrested 13 members of an inter-district robber gang on Dhaka-Tangail highway in Mirzapur upazila on Tuesday, reports our correspondent.

The arrestees are Robin Miah, 22, and Bazlu Miah, 40, of Pabna district, Samiur Rahman, 30, of Manikganj, Limon Miah, 30, of Bogra, Billal Hossain, 30, of Barguna, Masum Miah, 32, and Chand Miah, 35, of Barisal, Babul Miah, 24, of Sherpur, Bilal Sheikh, 25, of Gopalganj, Swadhin Miah, 25, of Dinajpur, Shawkat Hossain, 31, of

Munshiganj, Ripon Miah, 32, of Dhaka, and Alamgir Hossain, 35, of Madaripur.

Acting on a tip-off, a police team raided Deohata area on the highway around 8:00pm and arrested the 13 while they were preparing to loot valuables from bus passengers, said police.

Away in Barisal, the law enforcers in a drive arrested six robbers with a knife, one grill cutter and other sharp weapons at Dakkhin Karapur in Sadar upazila early yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The arrestees are Dulal Mridha, 35, Dalim, 28, Akhter Hossain, 27, Suman Sheikh, 35, and Sohag, 24. The name of the other could not be known.

Youth found dead

Police recovered the body of a mentally challenged youth from Chal Pukhuria village in Sadar upazila yesterday morning. The deceased is Shah Jalal, 21, son of Ruhul Amin of the village, and worker of a local tea stall. He went missing since Saturday, said family sources. Locals found his body hanging from a tree in the area and informed the police, said Md Enayet Hossain, officer-in-charge of Sadar Police Station. The body was sent to Pirojpur Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, said the OC.

Housewife commits 'suicide'

A housewife allegedly committed suicide in Mathbaria upazila of the district on Tuesday. The deceased is Sumi Begum, 22, wife of Jasim Uddin of Holta village. Family sources said Sumi took pesticide following an altercation with her husband over a family matter. She later died at the upazila health complex. The body was sent to Pirojpur Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy, said Khandakar Mostafizur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Mathbaria Police Station.

Lightning kills two

A woman and her niece were killed by lightning at Namakayakuri village under Nakla upazila of the district yesterday afternoon. The deceased are Delwara Begum, wife of Mafidul Islam, and her niece Bilkis Akhter, 11, daughter of Abul Kalam. Police and locals said they were struck by a thunderbolt while returning home with their cattle from a nearby field around 3:00pm. They died on the spot.

Rapist gets life

A Panchagarh court yesterday sentenced a youth to life imprisonment for raping a girl in 2013. The rapist is Md Firoz, 25, son of Hanif Uddin of Kaugoch village in Tentulia upazila. Judge of the Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal-1 MA Nur also fined the convict Tk one lakh. In default, he is to suffer another six months in jail. According to the prosecution, Firoz raped the girl in 2013, promising her to marry. The victim then filed a case with Tentulia Police Station, accusing Firoz. Police later pressed charges against Firoz. After examining the witnesses and evidence, the judge found him guilty and pronounced the verdict.

Dyke collapse floods 20 Sherpur villages

At least 20 villages in Nalitabari upazila of the district were flooded as 200 metres of a flood control embankment on the Bhogai River collapsed yesterday morning due to heavy rain and onrush of water from the upstream for the last few days.

Several thousand people of the affected villages, including Nalitabari, Marichpuran, Jogania, Khabhanga, Nalkura, Kharharia, and Gojakura, Banshkanda,

Kayarpar and Kapashia, have been marooned.

Besides, the roads and seedbeds of the areas went under water and fishes of around 50 ponds were washed away by the floodwater.

Abdul Hakim of Khabhanga village urged the government to take immediate steps for repairing the embankment.

Ashrafuzzaman, chairman of Nalitabari Union Parishad, said as

Khabhanga is the most dangerous point of the

embankment, the authorities concerned should take immediate steps to repair it.

Mokhlesur Rahman, a gauge reader of Water Development Board, said a portion of the embankment collapsed as the river has been flowing 58 centimetres above the danger level since Wednesday night.

Apart from this, several unions of Jhenagati upazila were inundated due to rise of water level in Moharashi, Someshwari, Jhenai and Kalaghusha rivers.

6 abducted fishermen freed after paying ransom

Six fishermen, abducted by a gang of robbers from Narikelbaria area on the Bay under Pathorghata upazila on June 3, were released on Tuesday after paying Tk 10 lakh as ransom.

They are Solaiman Majhi, 35, Ibrahim Mia, 40, Khalilur Rahman, 36,

Lokman Mia, 32, Anis Mia, 35 and Zakir Hossain, 38. They hail from different villages under Pathorghata upazila, said Md Golam Mostafa Chowdhury, president of Barguna district fishing trawler owners' association.

The robbers freed the fishermen at a place in Bagerhat upazila, he added.

Members of infamous 'Jahangir Bahini' of the

Sudarbans abducted them while they were catching fish in the Bay. They were tortured both mentally and physically, said Golam Mostafa, quoting the freed fishermen.

The gang had earlier demanded Tk 20 lakh ransom for release of the fishermen. They later freed them on payment of Tk 10 lakh, said a source.
